2013 SCYC Spring One Design Series

APRIL 20, MAY 18, AND JUNE 15, 2013

1 Rules

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The SCYC 2013 Minimum Equipment Requirements for US In Shore will apply. This document may be found at scyc.org
- 1.3 Rule 40 will be changed to require competitors to wear a personal flotation device while racing. Changes to the rules will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may change other rules.
- 1.4 Moore 24 class shall sail with three people aboard.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Boats of the Santana 22, Moore 24, and Santa Cruz 27 one-design classes are eligible to participate in this series. All other one-design classes may petition to participate if a minimum of at least three (3) boats is entered prior to 1100 hours April 20, 2013.
- 2.2 No race will be started for any class with fewer than three competitors in the starting area.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at Regatta Network or at scyc.org. Only on-line entries will be accepted.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$85.00 and is applicable if entry is competed by 2000 hour April 19th, 2013.
- 3.2 A late entry fee of \$100.00 is applied to all entries received after 2000 hours April 19th, 2013.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 1800 hours on June 14th, 2013.
- 3.4 All entry fees are nonrefundable.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 A competitors' meeting is scheduled for 1100 hours on April 20, 2013 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours each race day.
- 4.3 For the Moore 24 and Santa Cruz 27 classes, nine races (9) are scheduled for the series with three (3) races each race day.
- 4.4 For the Santana 22 class, six (6) races are scheduled for the series with two (2) races each race day
- 4.5 For all classes, four (4) races will constitute a series.
- 4.6 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse following the series.

5 Sailing Instructions

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors' meeting and on line at scyc.org.

6 Venue

6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a three-mile radius of the Walton Lighthouse on the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7 Courses

7.1 A course diagram will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

8 Scoring

8.1 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores excluding her worst score. This changes rule A2.

9 Prizes

9.1.1 Boats entered in classes with three (3) or more entries in the series are eligible for the Champion of Champions Regatta. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.
