Atlantic Coast Championship Laser Standard, Radial, and 4.7 Little Egg Harbor Yacht Club Beach Haven NJ June 8 - 9, 2013



1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US SAILING), the rules of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) and this Notice Of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is the Little Egg Harbor Yacht Club.

2 Language

The official language for this regatta will be English.

3 Inspection and Measurement

3.1 Sails may be measured prior to racing, and may also be spot checked at any time during the regatta. Note that numbers and letters drawn on the sail with permanent ink pens are not legal. Refer to http://www.laserinternational.org/sailnos.htm for detailed instructions.

4 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 Laser, Radial and Laser 4.7 competitors who are members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association may enter by completing registration with the organizing authority.
- 4.2 A minimum of five entries at the time of the early registration deadline are required to constitute a class.

5 Risk

5.1 It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

6.2 No warning signal will be made after 1530 on the final day of the regatta

7 Advance Registration

- 7.2 competitors attending the Orange Coffee Pot Regatta at SCYC may store boats at LEHYC between events. An area in the north parking lot will be marked on 6/1

8 Fees

- 8.1 Required Fees
- 8.2 The entry fee for Laser, Laser Radial and Laser 4.7 entries is \$115.
- 8.3 A late fee of \$25 will be charged after May 30.
- 8.4 The entry fee includes continental breakfast both days, water and sports bars for competitors during each race day, dinner on Saturday, chowder and hot dogs at the awards presentation and a t-shirt.
- 8.5 Non competitors may purchase breakfast and lunch and or saturday dinner

9 Housing

9.1 Housing will not be provided. A list of Hotels is available here. After "Sandy" our hotels are open and ready for guests while our members are still cleaning up.

10 Sailing Instructions

10.1 The sailing instructions will be available during on-site registration.

11 Courses & Racing Area

- 11.1 Courses will be the standard ILCA-NA trapezoid as described in the ILCA-NA Regatta Guidelines.
- 11.2 The racing area will be on Little Egg Harbor, about 1 1/2 miles northwest of the LEHYC clubhouse.

12 Scoring

- 12.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4, will be used except as modified below.
- 12.2 Seven races are scheduled, a minimum of 3 races must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 12.3 When six or more races are completed a sailor may discard their worst score.

13 Awards

- 13.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top five finishers in the Full and Radial fleets.
- 13.2 Prizes will be awarded to the top three places in the 4.7 fleet.

14 Support Boats

14.1 Support boat operators will be required to register and to provide a list of sailors they are supporting. Support boats will be mandated to lend assistance to other than the boats they support if conditions require.
