

## **Notice of Race**

2013 BAYS Summer Series Regatta #1 at PYSF May 18-19, 2013

## 1. Eligibility & Fees

- 1.1 There will be starts for 29er, C420, CFJ, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Opti Championship and Opti Green.
- 1.2 A minimum of five boats is needed to constitute a fleet.
- 1.3 Results will be scored as part of the BAYS 2013 Summer Series
- 1.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form online at <a href="http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/6819">http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/6819</a> by Thursday, May 16. Advanced registration is *mandatory*. There will be no new registrations on the day of racing.
- 1.4 The entry fee for this regatta is \$40 per sailor. Lunch and a light snack after racing will be provided.

## 2. Rules

- 2.1 The Regatta will be governed by The 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, and as modified by the NOR and Sailing Instructions for this Regatta.
- 2.2 Competitors are required to carry a bowline of at least fifteen feet attached to a towing point while racing.

- **4. Racing Area -** The race course will be located just outside Redwood Creek, or inside the turning basin adjacent to PYSF.
- **5. Coaching -** Coaching is not permitted during racing. Between races, coaching will be permitted, but coach boats shall not enter the racing area. All coach boats must also act as safety boats. Each boat must carry a VHF radio.
- **6. Safety -** Each competitor must wear adequate buoyancy, properly secured at all times, on the dock and while on the water. Wet suits, dry suits and inflatable PFDs do not constitute adequate buoyancy.
- **7. Liability** Participants compete entirely at their own risk. Each competitor and their parent/guardian must sign a waiver before competing.
