**RULES:** All races will be sailed in accordance with current Racing Rules of Sailing and with Class rules where applicable. Sailing instructions will be provided at Registration. One race constitutes a regatta. Six or more races will be attempted. If six or more races are completed, there will be a throw-out race.

**CLASSES:** Three boats are required to form a class. Expected classes include: Sunfish, Lasers, 470's, V-15's, Windsurfers, Catamarans and Portsmouth.

**AWARDS:** One trophy will be awarded for 3-4 boats, 2 for 5-7, 3 for 8-9

**DIRECTIONS:** Interstate 45 to Nasa Road One. East on Nasa Road One past Clear Lake. At Hwy 146, in Seabrook, Nasa Road One becomes Second Avenue.
