2013 J 24 Great Lakes & District 7 Championship

August 10-11, 2013

1. Host

The regatta will be hosted by **Oswego Yacht Club**. The new home of Oswego Yacht Club is the blue roofed building near the drysail area adjacent to Wright's Landing on Lake Street.

2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the 2013-2016 *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS.)*

3. Entry

The regatta is open to all properly registered J-24 boats. The OYC organizing authority must be in receipt of the completed registration form by July 27, 2012 for regular registration. Any registrations after that date must pay an additional \$15 late fee for entry. Onsite registration and check in will be 4-7 P.M. on Friday and 7:30-8:30 A.M. Saturday. A scale for crew weigh in will be available, and entry forms and fee schedule will posted on the OYC website by May 7, 2012; thereafter, please send completed forms to:

4. Insurance, Inspection and Measurement

Proof of insurance for property damage, and third party liability coverage of \$300,000 is required for all participants. Participants are required to carry a current measurement certificate and current J-24 class membership number.

5. Launching and Rafting

Launching and docking will be provided for all out-of-town boats adjacent to the Wrights Landing public marina on Lake Street. Competing boats will be launched by 2200 PM, August 9th, and will remain in the water with rudders affixed for the duration of the regatta unless prior written approval to haul is obtained by regatta officials. J-24's are subject to inspection by regatta officials at any time during the regatta.

6. Skippers Meeting

Skippers meeting will commence at 0830 August 10 at the OYC clubhouse deck, with racing on Lake Ontario's open waters to begin as soon as practical thereafter.

7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at check-in and on the Oswego Yacht Club web site and include course and mark descriptions.

8. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the RRS will apply. Seven races are scheduled. There will be a throw out when and if six races or more are completed. One completed race shall constitute a regatta. Top placing finisher from either district 7, 12, or 15 will receive a qualifying berth for the 2014 J24 World Championship in Newport RI.
