### **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

#### 1. RULES:

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Appendix T Section B (POST RACE PENALTIES) shall apply
- 1.3 For the Melges 24 class, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.4 For the J/120 and J105 classes, Appendix T Section A (PENALTIES WHILE RACING) shall apply.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following fleets: J/120, J/105, and IRC
- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration at <u>www.sfyc.org</u>.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$100 (\$95 for members of US SAILING).

2.4 If fewer than 5 boats in a class are entered by 1500 hrs on June 6, SFYC may refund the entry fees and not provide a start for that class.

#### **3. SCHEDULE OF RACES:**

#### 4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing instructions will be available after June 5, 2013, at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on our website, <u>www.sfyc.org</u>.

- **5. RACING AREA AND COURSES:** The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Olympic Circle. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.
- **6. COMMUNICATIONS:** The Race Committee may communicate information about the regatta via VHF radio.

#### 7. SCORING:

7.1 Five (5) races are scheduled, of which two (2) must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.

7.2 For one design boats, scoring will be the Low Point System of Appendix A. For IRC boats, scoring will be based on IRC handicap procedures.

- 8. DOCKAGE: The SFYC guest dock will be available from June 7 through June 9.
- **9. PRIZES:** Prizes will be awarded based on the number of boats entered in each class. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on Sunday.
