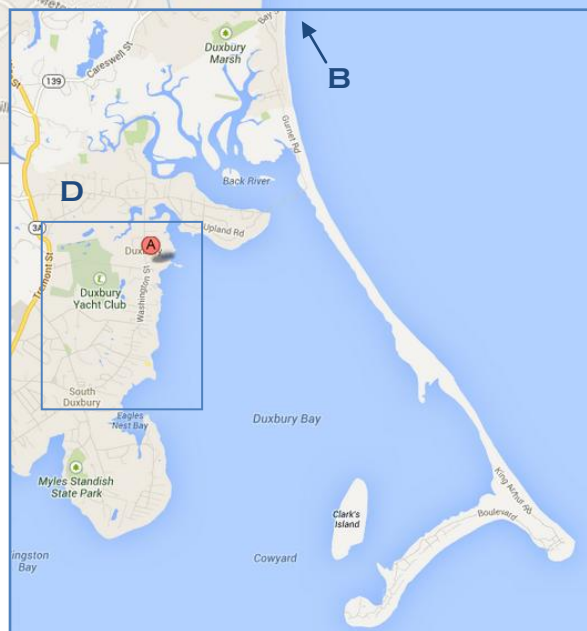
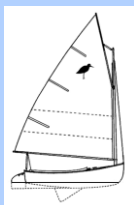
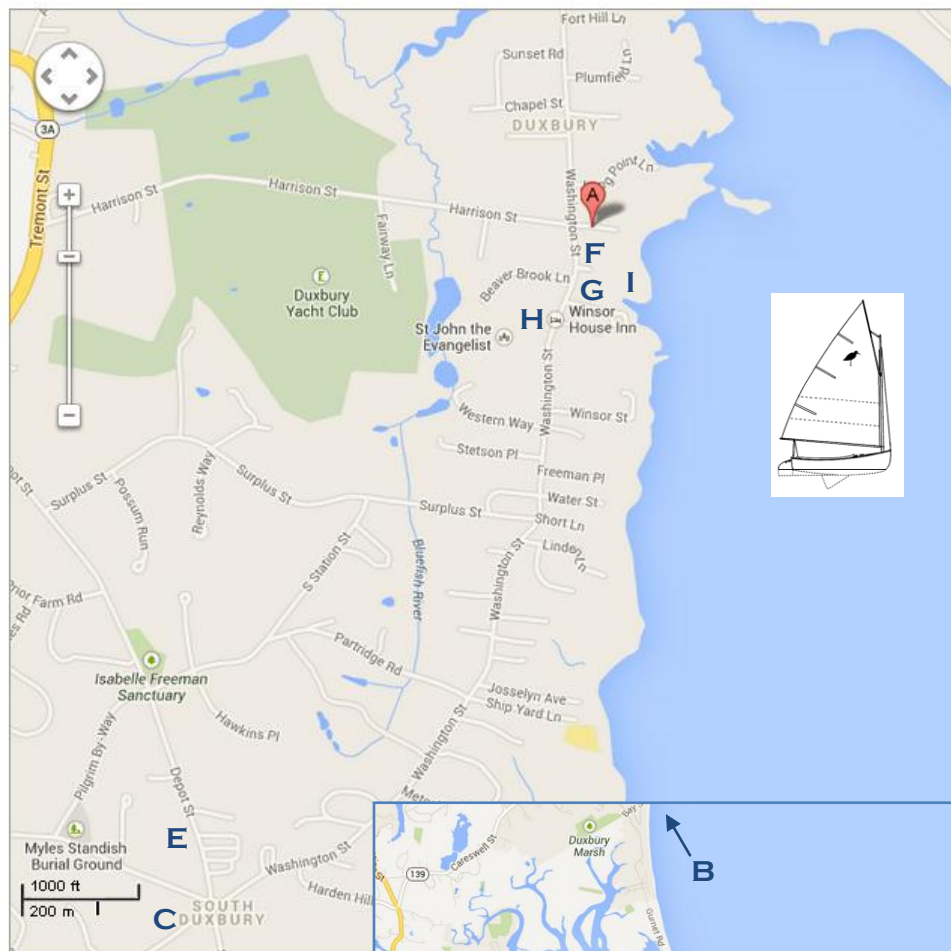

Waterfront dining and live music on weekends.

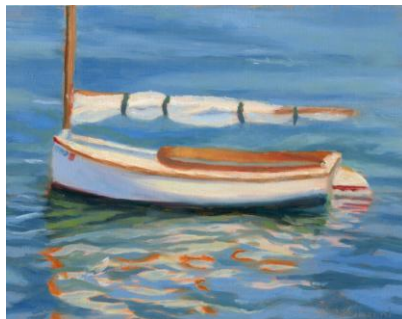
