

Knarr Invitational Regatta June 23, 2013

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

This regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the Sausalito YC website and emailed to the Knarr webmaster. Notices shall be posted no later than 2100 hrs, Saturday the night before racing. If notices have been posted, the committee boat shall fly flag "L" in the racing area.

3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

No signals shall be made ashore.

4 SCHEDULE and CLASS FLAG

Warning1130 hrsStart1135 hrs

Warning Signal shall be a 2'x2' red flag with white Knarr logo "0".

The Warning Signal for subsequent races shall be made as soon as practicticable.

Two races are scheduled. This amends the Notice of Race

5 COURSES and MARKS

Courses and mark despriptions will be defined on Attachment A. Couses shall be disignated by numerical pennant.

8 STARTING and FINISHING LINES

The intened starting area will be in the vicinity of Pt Knox, west of Angel Island. If conditions dictate, the committee boat may move to another area. If so, the race committee shall hail the fleet on VHF channel 71 and display the "L" flag. The starting and finishing line will be between an inflatable mark and an orange flag on the committee boat

9 TIME LIMIT

For all races the time limit shall be 15 minutes after the first boat in the class finishes that race. Boats finishing after the time limit shall be scored DNF. This changes RRS 35.

10 PROTESTS

Protests shall be in writing; forms available at the bar at Sausalito YC and delivered to the protest table within 60 minutes after the race committee boat docks.

The Protest time limit and a list of protests will be posted on the official notice board within 15 minutes of the end of protest time. This posting constitutes the notification required in RRS 61.1(b) and 63.2

11 SCORING

The Low Point System of Appendix A of the racing rules will apply. A minimum of one race shall be completed to constitute a series. All races count. No race shall be discarded.

12 COMMUNICATIONS

RRS 25 is amended to allow for on-the-water radio communications between the R/C and racing boats on VHF channel 71. The R/C will communicate OCS and the signaled course for the race. The inability of a competitor to hear a hail for over early or any other information shall not relieve her of her responsibility, nor shall it be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 41 and 62.1.

of Marks S/F Yellow


Inflatable cone
