

NOTICE OF RACE OCTOBER 26 & 27, 2013 GIBSON ISLAND YACHT SQUADRON 210 FLEET GIBSON ISLAND, MARYLAND

1. RULES

The Organizing Authority is the Gibson Island Yacht Squadron. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2013-2016 ("RRS"). Racing rule(s) will be changed as follows:

- 1.1 RRS A4.2 is changed so that a boat not starting within 10 minutes after the starting signal will be scored "DNS" without a hearing.
- 1.2 RRS 35 is changed to provide that boats finishing more than 30 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored DNF.
- 1.3 RRS 63.7 is replaced with: "If there is any conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall apply."

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Eligible boats shall be members of the International 210 class.
- On-line entry at http://giys.gibsonisland.com/race-regattas/registration-info/ by 2400 Hours October 18, 2013.
- 2.3 Entry fee is \$75.00, includes boat launching and storage. Please make checks payable to Gibson Island Yacht Squadron. Lodging may available at the Gibson Island Club cottage or in private homes.

4. INSURANCE

Race participants must be adequately insured against third party liability for racing risks. Proof of same may be requested.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at http://gibsonisland.com/yachtsquadron/race-regattas/registration-info/ and at 0800 on October 26, 2013, at registration.

6. RACING AREA

Racing will be conducted in the Magothy River west of Gibson Island, unless the location is changed based on weather conditions and subject to participants' agreement.

7. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A, will apply, as modified so that each series score will be the total of the races scored with the worst score excluded if more than four (4) races are completed. Five (5) races are scheduled, of which one (1) race shall be required to constitute a series.

8. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing 1st through 3rd place
