NOTICE OF RACE

August 18, 2013 at the Lido Isle Yacht Club Organizing Authority: Fleet 1 of the Harbor 20 Class Association

1. RULES

- 1. The race is a part of the Fleet 1 Caribbean Beach Party at the Lido Isle Yacht Club.
- 2. Fill your boat as desired with friends, family, pets, and refreshments.
- 3. The race will utilize a "pursuit" or reverse handicap start.
- 4. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and Harbor 20 Fleet 1 Bylaws.
- 5. RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be changed so that only a One-Turn Penalty (one tack and one gybe) is required.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 1. The regatta is open to all Harbor 20 boats.
- 2. Registrants must be members in good standing with the Harbor 20 Class Association and registered for the Caribbean Beach Party to be eligible to sail in this event. - 3. Fleet 1 Bylaw I.F.6 applies to this regatta.
- 4. Eligible boats must submit a completed registration form online at http://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet_registrant_list.php?regatta_id=7088&custom_report_id=33 (link can also be found at www.Harbor20.org) no later than 1200 hours on Saturday, August 17 or at the Lido Isle Yacht Club on Sunday, August 18 between 1200 and 1300 hours.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at the Lido Isle Yacht Club on Sunday, August 18. Amendments to the Sailing Instructions may be made by the RC at the competitors meeting

5. RACING

- 5.1. One race is scheduled.
- 5.1. The race will utilize a "pursuit" or reverse handicap start. Boats will start in groups of one or more at starting times to be determined by the RC. These starting times will be made available as an attachment to the Sailing Instructions and/or verbally no later than 1350 hours on August 18.
- 5.2. The race will start and finish in the harbor south of the Lido Isle Yacht Club.
- 5.3. The courses will be a random leg course. Possible course descriptions will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

6. SCORING

6.1. The Low Point Scoring System in RRS Appendix A will apply, except that no scores will be excluded.

7. PRIZES

- 7.1. Prizes will be awarded after racing during the Caribbean Beach Party.
- 7.2. The Harbor Heritage Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the boat determined by the RC to be the winner.

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

8.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
