2013 LITTLE BROWN JUG

Sunday, August 11, 2013 **11:00 First Warning Signal**

<u>Start</u>: Between the orange flag on the committee boat and Nun 2 at the entrance to Lloyd Harbor. Finish: Between the orange flag on the committee boat and Nun 2, unless shortened at another mark of the course. **Course:** One of the below courses shall be signaled from the committee boat using letter placards:

- A Traditional course of Bell "11B" to port and back, 11 nm.
- B To Flasher "1" off Sand City, to Bell "8" Target Rock, to finish at Nun "2"; or the reverse, 3.3 nm. Boats, at their discretion, may sail the course either clockwise leaving the marks to starboard, or counter-clockwise leaving the marks to port, except for the finish which shall be made by approaching the line directly from the direction of the previous mark. Racers are reminded to follow right of way rules when rounding marks.
- C Course B twice around, using Nun "2" off Lloyd Harbor as the turning mark to begin the second lap of the course, 6.6 nm – boats must complete both course rotations in the same direction.

Scoring: PHRF Time on Distance.

Sails: This is a jib and main race. No spinnakers of any variety may be used. Whisker poles of any length are permitted. **Divisions:**

<u>Time Limit</u> :	1515 Hours for all boats. Racers are reminded to report their withdrawal from the race to the race committee on VHF channel 72.
