NOTICE OF RACE



1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*
- 1.2 The prescriptions that may require advance preparation by teams are stated in full below.
The ISSA Procedural Rules and The Supplemental Rules of the PCISA
- 1.3 Class rules requiring CFJ or Club 420 class membership shall not apply.
- 1.4 All boats must use sails provided by HYSA** and enter in any designated round robin rotation.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Under ISAF Rule 20.3 this is a no advertising event, except that
- 2.2 Under ISAF Rule 20.4.1 ‘...The Organizing Authority or an event has the right to make use of the following spaces according to the following terms: ...’ under this rule boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 The regatta is open as follows: Qualifying Schools from every member District are eligible for this event. A school qualifies when they meet ISSA Rule 1. ELIGIBILITY
- 3.2 Teams must be a current member of ISSA. Schools may register as many full teams as desired.
- 3.3 Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader chaperone and must be identified at time of registration.
- 3.1 A team is comprised of a minimum of 4 sailors.
- 3.2 Schools sending less than 4 sailors can request that their team be supplemented with local (Hawaii) sailors. The request for supplemental sailors must be made in writing no later than 2100 hours HST Friday November 15 2013.
- 3.2.1 The team requesting supplemental sailors will be responsible to pay the full Entry Fee and Damage Deposit.

4. REGISTRATION and ENTRY

- 4.1 Registration for teams may only be made by completing the online forms at:

 - 4.1.1 Online registration will be open on 30 September 2013 through 15 November 2013.

- 4.3 Required fees are per team. Additional teams pay all fees and complete separate entry forms.

Entry Fee and Charter	\$280.00
Damage Deposit	\$250.00 (Make this a separate check to be destroyed at end of regatta if no damage)
- 4.4 The Entry fee includes charter boat and sail, daily breakfast and lunch, IMU* Luau for four (4), four (4) t-shirts, and trophies.
 - 4.4.1 The entry fee must be paid by credit card on-line at the time of registration.
 - 4.4.2 Additional tickets for the IMU* Luau and t-shirts can be purchased at the time of registration via online storefront.

4.5 A completed entry is defined as all forms having been completed on-line and all appropriate forms having been received by HYSA no later than 2100 hours HST 15 November 2013. Exceptions may be made at the discretion of HYSA.

4.6 No refunds of the entry fee will be made after 22 November 2013.

4.7 Teams unable to compete must notify HYSA c/o Alison Kiyotoki as soon as possible.

4.8 Availability is on a first come first served basis.

5. SAFETY & LIFEJACKETS

5.1 Lifejackets meeting U.S. Coast Guard regulations for Personal Floatation Devices (PFDs) Type III shall be worn. Non U.S. Coast Guard certified PFDs will not be allowed.

6. FLEET

6.1 The regatta will consist of one Fleet.

8.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available by Saturday 30 November 2013 at the Competitors' Meeting.

9. SCORING

9.1 The regatta will be scored in accordance with Official Procedural Rules for Interscholastic Sailing Competition.

9.2 Three (3) races must be completed to constitute a series.

10. VENUE

10.1 The host club will be Kaneohe Yacht Club.

10.2 The venue will be the waters of Kaneohe Bay directly to the west of the yacht club outside the coral patches that line the entrances to the harbor.

10.3 The practice will be at Kaneohe Yacht Club.

11. THE COURSES

11.1 Courses will be Windward Leeward variations detailed in an attachment to the Sailing Instructions.

12. PRIZES

12.1 Prizes will be given at the end of the regatta for Series Scores for 1st – 3rd Places.

12.2 Additional fun awards may be awarded.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY & MEDICAL RELEASE FORMS

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race.

13.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
