1. Rules, Eligibility and Event Classification

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013 2016*.
- 1.2. RRS 40 is changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal floatation device while racing.
- 1.3. Both Spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes will be run.

2. Eligibility and Entry:

- 2.1. The regatta is open to any Boats with a valid Northern California PHRF certificate. The Skipper and crew must be all women
- 2.2. Those boats without certificates will be assigned a PHRF rating at the sole and un-appealable discretion of the Race Committee
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing their application at www.southbeachyachtclub.org.

3. Entry fees

- 3.1. Entry fees are as follows: \$20 if received by (enter date); \$30 if received after (3 days before race).
- 3.2. Late registration will be held on-site on October 6 between 1000 and 1100.

4. Schedule of Races

- 4.1. Racing will be held on October 6, 2013.
- 4.2. The scheduled time for the first Warning Signal is 13:00 hours.
- 4.3. Two races will be scheduled
- 4.4. No race will be started after 1600 hours

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available by October 3, 2012 at 1800 hours, on the SBYC Club Website under the Racing Page at www.southbeachyachtclub.org The Sailing Instructions will also be made available at the SBYC Clubhouse the day of the race by 1030 hours.

6. Venue

6.1. The race will be sailed in the South Bay Waters of San Francisco Bay located in the general area east of South Beach Harbor and around Anchorage 9.

7. Courses

7.1. Courses may be either Temporary or Fixed Marks.

8. Scoring

- 8.1. The Time on Time Scoring method will be used.
- 8.2. There will be no throw outs.

9. Prizes

9.1. Trophies for first, second and third places will be awarded. Trophies for other categories may be awarded as well. Trophies must be picked up by SBYC's close of business on the day of the regatta.
