- 1. Rules The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- Eligibility and Crew The Fall 48 regatta is open to all Flying Scots. The Carolinas District Championship is open to all helmsmen whose primary residence is in, or who belong to a Fleet within, the Carolinas District. All Fall 48 and Carolinas District Championship helmsmen must be current members of the FSSA. You can join FSSA by going to <u>www.fssa.com</u> or calling 800-445-8629.
- 3. Fees: Entry Form and payment must be received or postmarked by Friday, October 25th to qualify for early registration.

- 5. **Sailing Instructions** Sailing instructions will be available at registration, and the NOR will be posted on the Official Notice Board on the lower level of the Race Management Center.
- 6. **Number of Races** A maximum of five races are scheduled, and one race must be completed to constitute the Fall 48 regatta and the Carolinas District Championship.
- 7. Courses Windward-Leeward (WL) or Modified Windward-Leeward (MWL).
- 8. **Scoring** Will be according to the RRS Appendix A Low Point system. Each boat's score shall be the total of her races scores with no race excluded. This changes RRS A2. The Carolinas District Championship will be scored along with the Fall 48.
- 9. **Safety** A boat retiring from a race shall notify a Race Committee vessel before leaving the course, or when that is impossible, as soon as possible after arrival ashore.
- 10. **Club Info** Camping at the club is free to everyone; however pets and open fires are not allowed. Please visit <u>www.lnyc.org</u> for directions.
- 11. Prizes Trophies will be awarded as follows:
 - a. Fall 48, 1st 8th places
 - b. Carolinas District Championship, 1st 3rd places
- 12. **Registration** The options are:

To qualify for Early Registration, you must complete your entry form and make your payment by October 25th. You will need to sign the Release and Waiver on-site at the Registration table.
 - b. <u>Standard Mail</u> Fill out the Entry Form on the next page, sign the Release and Waiver, and mail the form and your check to the name and address at the bottom of the form. **To qualify for** Early Registration, your submission must be postmarked by October 25th.
 - c. <u>On-site</u> See NOR 4. Event Schedule for the date, time and location. Late fees will apply.
