NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, together with prescriptions of the US Sailing, A-Class Catamaran, Nacra 20, F16 and CBYRA Beach Cat rules, also to include any additional sailing instructions issued at the competitors' meeting.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the A-Class Catamaran, Nacra 20, F16 classes.
- 2.2. Entries are accepted in the A class and the CBYRA Beach Cat Class
 - Class trophies for F16, Nacra 20's and A-Class Catamaran will be awarded.
 - The perpetual Rob Wilson Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner of all fleets as scored under Portsmouth Yardstick.
- 2.3. Eligible boats are strongly encouraged to register by visiting the CRAC regatta registration site at http://www.regattanetwork.com/clubs/wrsc.php. To be considered timely, entries must be received by 11:59 pm, Friday, October 11, 2012
- 2.4. Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions:
 - Completing a registration form and paying the appropriate fee plus a \$10 late/on-site registration charge at the on-site registration table in the club house.

3. Fees

- 3.1. Required fees are as follows:
 - Double handed boats \$65.00
 - Single handed boats \$45.00
 - \$5.00 discount if you are a US Sailing member
 - Late fee \$10.00

4. Starts

4.1. The Beach Cat Classes (F-16's and Nacra 20's) fleet and the A Class fleet will have separate starts. The start for each fleet will be indicated by an appropriate class flag.

5. Scoring

- 5.1. The low point system of Appendix A of the racing rules will apply.
- 5.2. The completion of at least one race shall constitute a series. One drop score will be included if five or more races are sailed.

6. Prizes

- 6.1. Prizes will be given as follows
 - Each class racing will be awarded based on 1st/4, 2nd/6, 3rd/8 or more starters.
 - Double handed classes (Nacra 20, F16) (skipper and crew)
 - Single handed classes (A-Class, F16) (skipper)
 - The perpetual Rob Wilson Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the overall catamaran winner of the fleet with the greatest number of starters. If that fleet is comprised of non-one-design boats, then the scoring for the Rob Wilson Memorial Trophy will be determined according to Portsmouth Yardstick handicapping.

7. Food and Beverage

- 7.1. Dinner will be provided after the racing on Saturday.
- 7.2. The cash bar at WRSC will be open on Saturday afternoon and evening.
