1. Authority

This regatta is organized under the authority of the Lauderdale Yacht Club and will be sailed under the management of the LYC Race Committee. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016, the prescriptions of U S Sailing, the class rules of each class invited to compete as they apply to that class, the Sailing Instructions and any other applicable rules. In case of a conflict of any of the above the Sailing Instructions will prevail. Changes to any racing rules in accordance with RRS 86 will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

2. Classes

The regatta is open to the following classes:

International Optimist Dinghy (all fleets), Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Club 420 and 29er. A minimum of five boats per class is required. All Ocean classes must carry a tow line of at least 25 feet in length and at least 1 / 4 inch in diameter.

3. Entry

On-line Registration and entry fee payment is available via Regatta Network on the Lauderdale Yacht Club web-site, www.lyc.org. Pre-registration ends January 10, 2014. On-line registration will end January 23, 2014. Boats entering the event must check in on site to complete registration. Boats completing registration with the LYC Race Committee are eligible to compete. Entry Fees are described on the Entry Form.
