NOTICE OF RACE

Rules 1.

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 All entrants will start together and be scored as a single fleet. Competitors may choose Standard, Radial, or 4.7 rigs at their discretion, provided that all rig changes are made on shore and all sails have the same number (Rig-Swapping Rule on). This changes ILCA Class Rule 27(d) by permission of the ILCA-NA.
- All hails will use the last 4 digits of the sail number. 1.3
- The organizing authority may issue colored bands to be applied to the mast. 1.4

<u>2</u>. **Eligibility and Entry**

- 2.1 Members of the ILCA who have reached the age of 35 by the first day of the regatta may enter.
- 2.2 Proof of ILCA membership will be required at Registration, and ILCA forms will be available.

- No entries will be accepted after 1000 Tuesday, February 11. 2.4

<u>3.</u> Fees

- Registration and entry fees must be received at USSCMC no later than Monday, 03 February 2014. 3.1 The entry fee is \$80/boat.
- All registrations received from 04 February to 11 February 2014 will be charged an additional \$25 late fee. 3.2
- 3.3 Entry fee includes continental breakfast Tuesday and Wednesday morning, bottled water and snacks while sailing, Tuesday evening beer and steaks and awards Wednesday after sailing.

There will be a maximum of 4 races per day.

5. Inspection and Measurement

- 5.1 Boats, gear, and sails may be inspected at any time for conformance to Class Rules.
- 5.2 Sail numbers must be the full 5 or 6 digits, must be applied in accordance with Class Rules, and must have the builder button.

6. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7. Courses

Courses will be windward-leeward or triangle as shown in the sailing instructions.

8. Scoring

- 8.1 A minimum of one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 8.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 8.3 The NA Masters handicap system will be used to score the overall series. For each race: Apprentices add 3 points Masters add 2 points Grand Masters add 1 point Great Grand Masters add 0.
- 8.4 Eight races are scheduled.

9. Prizes

1st Overall, 1st-3rd Apprentice Master, 1st-3rd Master, 1st-3rd Grand Master, 1st-3rd Great Grand Master, 1st Woman

10. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
