RULES

The regatta will be governed by the ICSA Procedural Rules (2013 - 2016), the ISSA Procedural Rules (as modified by the PCISA), the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING (US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2, 63.4 are deleted); the rules of the CFJ Class or PCCSC regarding Collegiate FJ's (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions, or the ICSA/ISSA Procedural Rules); and by the Sailing Instructions.

FORMAT & ELIGIBILITY

College Fleet

One Team (A & B) CFJ Division may enter from each ICSA member school previously approved by the ICSA Inter-conference Regatta Coordinator. Total college fleet limit of 30 teams.

College JV Fleet

Multiple Teams (A & B) CFJ Division may enter from each ICSA member school previously approved by the ICSA Inter-conference Regatta Coordinator. Total College JV fleet limit 30 teams.

High School Fleets

High School will be sailed in two fleets Gold and Silver, each fleet with an A & B Division. Final Fleet allocation will be done by PCISA. Total high school fleet limit of 60 teams. Teams should enter as Gold or Silver as they have sailed earlier in the season or contact the PCISA President to discuss changes.

A and B divisions in ALL fleets will sail separately (i.e. College A then High School A - rotate boats - College B then High School B).

BOATS & SAILS

College Fleets

Each team entered is responsible for providing "one" PCCSC legal CFJ and sails for this event. Outside California schools will be provided a boat and sails by the host for the Varsity Fleet.

All College JV Teams must bring boats & sails. College JV will use the boat you bring for all races.

All College Varsity boats will be entered in a round robin format!!

High School Fleet

Each team is responsible for providing one class legal CFJ. Sails will be provided by the PCISA. **All High School boats will be entered in a round robin format!!**

6. **SKIPPERS' MEETING, SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & CHECK IN**

All teams should check in at the registration table on the beach near or under a tent between the Belmont Pier and the Belmont Pool first thing Saturday morning. There will be a skippers' meeting at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, January 4, 2014 under or near the tent. Sailing Instructions will be available at the check in table under the tent. Check in will begin at 8:30am.
7. **ENTRY**

The online entry form must be completed by 5pm on December 20, 2013. Entry fees must be paid in full with the online entry and by the deadline. It is likely that late entries will not be accepted. Access the online entry system via: www.uscsailing.org; www.usclub.org or www.pcisa.org
8. **ENTRY FEES**

Entry Fees are \$130.00 per team (College or H.S.) and they are due with online registration by 5pm on December 20, 2013. There will be a late entry fee of \$150.00 for entry registrations or entry fee payments made after December 15, 2013. The entry fee includes 5 dinners per team. Additional dinners are available at \$15.00 each and can be purchased via the online registration. We would prefer additional dinner reservations in advance, but we may accept dinner reservations until 10:00am on Saturday, 1/04/14 if not sold out.
9. **SAILING AREA/LAUNCHING**

The sailing area for all fleets will be in the Long Beach Harbor next to the Belmont Memorial Pier. There will be two race courses – One for College Varsity & High School Gold and One for High School Silver & College JV. From noon Friday January 3, 2014 until dark on Sunday January 5, 2014 trailers can be parked in the parking lot between the Belmont Memorial Pier and the Belmont Olympic Pool (at the end of Termino Ave.) and boats can be kept on dollies on the beach. There will be security at the beach after dark on Friday and Saturday nights.
10. **PARTICIPATION**

With the exception of RRS Rule 4, each school shall compete in all scheduled races or if unable to compete take care of their assigned boat. Any school breaking this rule, without permission of the Race Committee, is subject to severe disciplinary actions by the PCISA/PCCSC/ICSA.
11. **TROPHIES**

Trophies will be awarded to teams placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each fleet.
12. **T – SHIRTS**

T – Shirts will be available at a discounted \$12.00 each when **pre-ordered**, and **prepaid** by **December 20th via the online registration**. T-shirts will also be sold at the event for \$15.00.
13. **SATURDAY DINNER**

There will be a dinner in the Del Mar Room of the Belmont Olympic Pool building on Saturday, Jan. 4th immediately after racing for all participants, family, friends and guests. The entry fee includes five (5) dinners. Additional dinners will be available at \$15.00 per person and can be ordered online with registration or by calling the US Sailing Center by the entry deadline. Additional dinner reservations may be available until 10:00 a.m. on Saturday Jan. 4, 2014 if there is space available.
14. **COLLEGE SAILING FORUM**

There will be a short presentation on Intercollegiate Sailing following dinner on Saturday night. Students and parents interested in information about college sailing in general, or specific collegiate programs should plan to attend. All colleges should plan to be represented.
