

Notes about Racing with HCYC

VHF Radio channel If LCYC is also using #69 at the same time, then precede call with HCYC as in HCYC Chase boat to HCYC Committee boat	69
Preferred means to communicate with RC or mark set boat	Please call on VHF channel 69.
Hails across the water to RC or Mark set boat	<p>(1) 41c states help a boat may receive is in the form of information freely available to all boats. Calling by channel 69 makes questions and answers freely available to all boats.</p> <p>(2) Hails across the water co be easily misunderstood</p> <p>(3) Hails across the water may only be heard by nearby boats.</p>
Poison Line	The start-finish line shall not be crossed anytime except when starting or finishing.
Courses F* I* verses F I	<p>F* I* Means the start – finish line is restricted aka poison</p> <p>F I without an * means start –finish line is not poison</p>
Failure to check in	Being in the area is not enough, Checking in is done by sailing past the stern of the RC boat per sailing instructions
