1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 US prescriptions to RRS 60, 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply.
- 1.3 RRS 63.7 will be replaced by: "If there is a conflict between a rule in the notice of race and one in the sailing instructions, the sailing instructions shall apply."
- 1.4 The J/70 Class Rules (CR) I.1 (Spare Gennaker) and I.3 (Support Boats) will apply.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising shall conform to the current ISAF Regulation 20 in accordance with each boat's Class Rules.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display identification numbers and/or sponsor's advertising for the duration of the event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20. These items will be supplied free of charge by the Organizing Authority (OA) at registration.
- 2.3 Boats required to, but not bearing identification numbers and/or sponsor's advertising as defined at registration are subject to protest by the race committee only. The protest committee may impose a penalty as it deems appropriate. This changes Rule 60.1(a).
- 2.4 Competitors are requested to respect the brand exclusivity of our Official Sponsors; their participation enhances the event for all competitors.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 This event is open to members of US Sailing, and/or members of I-LYA yacht clubs and/or members of One Design Class Associations. A boat shall be considered entered when proof of the above membership and a complete entry form is submitted, and all entry fees have been paid.
- 3.2 Racing is offered for Tartan 10's, J-24's, J-22's, J-70's, J-105's, J-120's, Dragons, Ensigns, Jet 14's, Highlanders and other one-design fleets. Separate starts are scheduled for classes with six or more paid entries before the early entry deadline of June 1, 2014. Any class not listed may contact the organizer and request their class's inclusion. Inclusion will require the class to have six (6) or more paid entries before the early entry deadline of June 1, 2014.

4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 Registration is available online at <u>www.RegattaNetwork.com</u> or <u>www.eycweb.com/cleveland-race-week</u> or <u>www.clevelandraceweek.com</u> or in person at Edgewater Yacht Club.
- 4.2 The final registration deadline for the One Design Regatta is June 12th, 2014 at 12:00pm. The early registration deadline is June 1st, 2014 at 12:00pm.
- 4.3 The entry fee includes one wrist band, storage, launching, racing, and parties. Payment may be made by Edgewater Yacht Club club charge, credit card, or PayPal. **Beer, food and blender drinks require a wristband.**

6. MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 All competitors are required to have a valid measurement certificate.
- 6.2 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with class rules and the sailing instructions.
- 6.3 T-10 Class rule regarding weigh-in shall be amended to allow boats to disclose crew weight in writing with registration. Weights may be checked during the Regatta Series to insure compliance.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

8. RACING AREA

8.1 Racing will take place on multiple courses in the open waters of Lake Erie immediately North of Edgewater Yacht Club.

9. SCORING

9.1 The regatta will be scored in accordance with the low point system of RRS Appendix A and may be modified by the Sailing Instructions.

10. GUEST DOCKAGE AND LAUNCHING

- 10.1 All keelboats must launch at least one hour before the 1st warning signal for the first race of their series. Once launched, no keelboat shall be hauled out of the water until after the last race of the series. Three two ton hoists and a fixed mast gin pole are available for self-launching. A free Metropolitan Park launching ramp is immediately adjacent to Edgewater Yacht Club.
- 10.2 In and out Travel lift service for boats arriving on trailers that require it, will be provided free of charge. Courtesy notice to the Club Office in advance at 216-281-6470 is requested
- 10.3 Complimentary dockage will be provided to all boats from Wednesday June 11th through Wednesday June 18th. Complimentary trailer storage is available. All trailers must be moved to storage as directed within one hour of launching. Instructions will be provided upon arrival.

11. PARKING & CAMPING ON SITE

11.1 Edgewater Yacht Club is a small footprint urban yacht club. Parking is at a premium. Nonmember cars are not allowed inside the yacht club parking lot to park. Competitors may park in designated areas less than 100 yards away in the adjacent Metropolitan Park. Camping is not allowed in the adjacent Metropolitan Park. Tent camping is not allowed on YC Property. To accommodate competitors who wish to stay on site, vehicles will be allowed inside the Edgewater Yacht Club gate after 7:00pm each night. Vehicles must be moved out of the EYC parking lot before 8:00am each day. EYC bathrooms will be available 24 hours per day to nonmembers.



12. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

12.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board located on the patio of the main Yacht Club building.

13. PRIZES

13.1 Prizes will be awarded to skippers and crews placing first through third and daily winners. Additional prizes may be awarded for large classes.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
