Eligibility: The regatta is open to any boat in the following classes:

PHRF A0	PHRF C	J/24
PHRF A1	Cal 25	J/30
PHRF A2	Catalina 27	J/105
PHRF B		

Rendezvous: At 1600 in vicinity of Severn River R"2" (Region 3 Annapolis Area Mark "X").

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between yellow flag on Race Committee boat and nearby inflatable or government mark. The first warning signal is scheduled for 1700. See the Event Sailing Instructions for starting sequence.

Signals: RRS 26 "Starting Races".

Course: Annapolis Area Region 3 standard racing marks as designated by letters displayed on Race Committee boat. The Race Committee may shorten the course. Note – New Region 3 standard marks will be added in 2014. Please consult the 2014 Green Book.

Finish: Between yellow flag on Race Committee boat and last mark of course.

Time Limit: Midnight for all classes. Boats not finishing within one hour of the first boat in their class to finish will be scored TLE and awarded points equal to the number of finishers plus two, but in no case more than the number of starters. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

Protests: Mail to SSC Race Committee, at address above, postmarked no later than Monday 23 June 2014. Hearing at a time and place to be announced.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7 & 4th/10+ starters.

Other: IMPERATIVE: Each yacht is responsible for following the *CBYRA General Sailing Instructions* for racing and finishing at night.

Event Sailing Instructions will be available on the SSC website www.shearwatersc.net not later than 1700 on Friday 20 June 2014.

Comment: In conjunction with the Twilight Race, the Shearwater Sailing Club will be offering a new race for boats that do not normally participate in CBYRA events. This Racing is Fun Race will start in the vicinity of the Severn River weather buoy "AN" several hours prior to the start of the Twilight race. It will use a course defined by government marks and finish after the start of the Twilight Race. The course and scoring for this new race will be separate from the Twilight Race defined in this NOR.
