

Attention all Region II and III racers:

(Cruisers, too)

MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR JUNE 7TH - PSA MOONLIGHT RACE

Building on the successes learned from changes PSA made to its Rock Hall race, (formerly Queenstown), PSA is tweaking a few aspects of their former **Overnight Race** as follows:

1. **Short on crew?** NO problem! We've added a new **Double-handed class** (please fly yellow "Q" flag)
2. **More of a cruiser than a racer?** Great! We have a special **cruising class** just for you!
3. All fleets will sail the short course except the Multihull A class, sailing the long course
4. The **"short" course** is now 25.08 nautical miles – 1.9 miles longer than before
5. The **"long" course** is now 35.6 nautical miles – 2.4 miles shorter than before
6. Sandy Point Light is no longer a mark of the course, replaced by "F" Red Fl 4 sec, in between Baltimore Light and Sandy Point Light
7. Mark D – northwest of Love Point light has been added
8. **Baltimore Light - start and finish**, course using government region II marks

It is hoped that these changes will (a) increase Region II participation with "bonus points" awarded for long distance races and (b) deep draft boats will no longer have an issue rounding Sandy Point Light to port and (c) racers will finish by midnight to head into PSA's all-you-can-eat breakfast. Skippers and crew can come by land or sea, and are welcome to tie up at PSA's dock.

Just head west up the Magothy River to Red Mark "10", then north into Blackhole Creek. The channel is between the two marks at the mouth of the creek, keep the island to port. PSA Clubhouse is behind the island on the western shore of the creek.
