## Organizing Authority & Host Club: Lake Norman Yacht Club

- 1. <u>Rules</u>: The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and Class Rules, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.
- Eligibility: The regatta is open to one-design keelboats and keelboats with a current LNKC PHRF
  Rating Certificate. (If the boat has not been rated, submit pertinent information to the Lake Norman
  Keelboat Council at <a href="http://www.lnkc.com">http://www.lnkc.com</a> to have a provisional rating assigned. No rating will be
  changed after completing registration.)
- 3. <u>Entry</u> Entry shall be made using Regatta Network (<u>www.regattanetwork.com/event/8025</u>). <u>Registration prior to arriving for check-in is highly encouraged.</u> Although entry is not complete until payment is received, registered boats may provide payment at check-in.
- 4. <u>Classes</u>: Entrants may register for a one-design class or for PHRF Non-Spinnaker or Spinnaker. Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker Fleets may be further divided into Divisions. Boats entering in a one-design class will be given a separate start if a minimum of five like boats registered.

- 7. **Sailing Instructions**: Will be available at Check-in.
- 8. Race Area: The racing area will be on Lake Norman in close proximity to the Lake Norman Yacht Club.
- 9. <u>The Courses</u>: The courses to be sailed will be windward leeward, around the buoys. Six races are scheduled. One race completed, shall constitute a regatta.

#### 10. **Scoring**:

- a. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores excluding her worst score.
- c. For Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker fleets, the PHRF Handicap System will be used and the Time on Distance Low Point Scoring System A2 shall apply.
