NOTICE OF RACE



Organizing Authority: Eagle Creek Sailing Club

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016.
- 1.2 US Sailing Regulation
- 1.3 **ALTERATION TO THE RULES**
These changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.
 - 1.3.1 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors to wear US Coast Guard (USCG) approved type III or V Personal flotation Device (PFD), inherently buoyant (i.e. no inflatables) while on the water, except for brief periods while changing clothing.
 - 1.3.2 RRS A4 & 5 will be changed to require a whistle attached to the PFD (lifejacket). Competitors not complying with this instruction may be given a penalty, without a hearing, of five (5) points for each race in which they have failed to observe this instruction.
 - 1.3.3 RRS 60.1 (a) will be changed to prohibit a boat from protesting another boat for alleged breach of any class rules other than class equipment measurements rules.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 This regatta is open to boats in the following classes: Laser Radial, C420, and Optimist.
- 3.2 All competitors must be individuals or family member of US Sailing at the time of the event.
- 3.3 This regatta is open to any junior sailor who will be 7 years or older on January 1, 2014 and including the summer immediately following their senior year of high school.

4. REGISTRATION AND ENTRY

- 4.1 Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online at www.RegattaNetwork.com/event/8094. An entry is not considered complete until payment has been received.
- 4.2 The entry fee includes: official USA Junior Olympic T-shirt, light breakfast Saturday and Sunday (8am-10am), Saturday dinner and prizes, and Sunday cook-out after racing.
- 4.3 Registrations after June 2nd may not receive the T-Shirt and/or dinners.

6. MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 All classes are required to use their class compliant equipment: Laser Radial, C420 and Optimist.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 The sailing instructions will be available by check-in day and on the online notice board. (www.ecsail.org)

8. SCORING

- 8.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.
8.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
8.3 When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
8.4 When six (6) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
8.5 Ten (10) races are scheduled; No more than 10 races will be run.

9. CONDUCT OF COMPETITORS

- 9.1 All competitors are expected to maintain the highest levels of conduct throughout the entire event. RRS 69.1

10. PRIZES

- 10.1 Take home prizes will be awarded in all classes to the top FOUR (4) boats as soon as possible after the last race on Sunday.

11. COACH/SAFETY BOATS

- 11.1 Eagle Creek Reservoir has a 10 horsepower limit on all motorized power boats.
11.2 All coach/safety boats must be register with the ECSC race administrator prior to launching.
11.3 Support boat personnel may request the use of a motor larger than 10 horsepower if such request is received by the ECSC administrator prior to June 7, 2014. NOTE: Such boats must be clearly marked as safety boats on both sides and their primary use on the course is to be able to assist race officials with safety and other duties.

12. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 12.1 Camping will be permitted on the grounds. All dogs must be on a leash. Check out our web page for numerous hotels with-in the area (www.ecsail.org).
