



The Classic Class cordially invites you to compete in the SYC Spring & Fall Series.

The first race is SYC Opening Regatta on April 13th.

A little about the Classics:

Classic Course: Our intention is to run a little more "civilized" race using fixed marks in a triangle configuration. As always, the Race Committee has ultimate control over the course but they are well aware of our wishes. We will be sailing one race per day with a total of four races for Spring & four races for Fall.

Divisions: We have divided up the fleet based on type of vessel. We have three Spinnaker divisions and one Non-Spinnaker division.

Classic: A Classic Yacht shall be wet sailed, have inboard propulsion and a cruising interior (standing headroom, permanently installed & plumbed head/shower, galley, lighting, sleeping berths). A Classic Yacht shall be rigged with a symmetrical spinnaker with exception made for those vessels whose asymmetrical spinnaker and sprit pole does not exceed the measurements described in GYA Appendix C #4a that result in a -3 second rating adjustment ("up to 2.5' of extended pole...asymmetrical spinnaker, measured in accordance with the Americas Cup formula, cannot exceed 123% of a standard PHRF symmetrical spinnaker").

Sport: Any vessel so designated as Sport by the GYA at the beginning of the racing season.

Performance: Any vessel neither falling under the definition of Classic or Sport above.

Non-Spinnaker: Any vessel wishing to sail without the benefit of a spinnaker

- All vessels must have a current PHRF certificate and be a member of the Classic Class (dues are \$50).
- We intend to have daily awards with a keg of beer at the SYC Tiki Bar after each race with the exception of SYC Opening & Closing, as a party is scheduled and trophies are awarded for these races.
- Trophies will be awarded to any division with three or more vessels.
