Notice of Race

1. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* for 2013-2016 ("RRS") and the rules of the International Star Class Racing Association ("STCR") except as stated herein or the Sailing Instructions.

- 1.1 RRS 35 is changed to provide that boats finishing more than 30 minutes after the first boat finished will be scored "Time Limit Expired" and will be scored two points more than the number of finishers. However, no boat will receive a score worse than the number of points awarded a DNF.
- 1.2 RRS 62.2 and 66 is changed to shorten the time for requesting redress and requesting that a hearing be re-opened to the last day of racing.
- 1.3 RRS 63.7 is replaced with: "If there is any conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall apply."

2. ENTRY DEADLINE

- 2.1 **Deadline for entries is Friday, July 11, 2014.** Entries received after July 11, 2014, will incur a \$25.00 late fee.
- 2.2 Entries shall be submitted online at http://gibsonisland.com/yachtsquadron/race-regattas/registration-info/

3. Entry Fee

The entry fee is \$110.00. Checks made payable to Gibson Island Yacht Squadron must be delivered no later than registration on July 19, 2014. Entry fee includes boat and trailer parking, launching, hauling and tickets for dinner on Saturday night at the Gibson Island Club for skipper and crew. Additional dinner tickets are \$30.00 per person. Please RSVP to Murray Leigh, star7454@gmail.com, by July 11, 2014, with the number people who will attend the Saturday dinner. Murray Leigh is also the contact for housing arrangements.

5. Insurance

Race participants must be adequately insured against third party liability for racing risks. Proof of same may be requested.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at http://gibsonisland.com/yachtsquadron/race-regattas/registration-info/ and at 0800 on July 18, 2014, at registration.

7. RACING AREA

Racing will be conducted in the Chesapeake Bay east of Gibson Island, unless the location is changed based on weather conditions and subject to participants' agreement.

8. COURSES AND PROCEDURES

Courses and procedures will be according to STCR 34.

9. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A, will apply, as modified so that each series score will be the total of the races scored with the worst score excluded if more than four (4) races are completed. Five (5) races are scheduled, of which one (1) race shall be required to constitute a series.

10. PRIZES

Series prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing 1st through 3rd place. Awards will also be given for the first place boat in the Masters (skippers age 50 through 59), Grand Masters (skippers age 60 and above) and Novice Divisions and for the highest-placing older boat (hull numbers to 7300).
