

NOTICE OF RACE

- 1. The Coconut Grove Sailing Club (CGSC) will host the annual Goombay Regatta on Biscayne Bay May 24 & 25, 2014. <u>PHRF boats will race on Saturday, May 24th</u>. <u>One Design boats will race on Sunday, May 25th</u>.
- 2. The races will be governed by the Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, BBYRA Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, Part I General Conditions, One Design and Cruising, Sections 2, 4.2, 5.1, 7, 8.1, 9, 10.1, 12, 13 and 14; Part II Sailing Instructions: One Design; Part III Sailing Instructions: Racing/Cruising; and Part IV Championships, Scoring and Awards, Section S2.1 and this Notice of Race. Current BBYRA Registration is not required for this regatta. No separate Sailing Instructions will be issued.
- 3. The September 2013 August 2014 BBYRA General Conditions and Sailing Instructions may be downloaded from <u>www.bbyra.net</u>.
- 4. All PHRF boats not having a PHRF certificate will be assigned a PHRF Racing, Cruising/Racing or Non-Spinnaker Rating (contact Russ Horn, <u>rhorn@mhs.net</u> or 954-224-5418). J-24's, J-22's, Sonar, ARC boats and others will be put into the appropriate class based on their assigned PHRF rating. (PHRF Applications may be downloaded from <u>www.phrfsef.com</u>.) The Race Committee reserves the right to divide the classes.
- To Enter, go to http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/8389. Entry Fees payable on line are: \$20 for Saturday's PHRF race; \$15 for One Design boats racing on Sunday. Entries must be made on-line no later than 1800 Hours on Wednesday, May 21, 2014 for PHRF boats, and 0900 Hours Sunday, May 25, 2014, for One Designs.
- The PHRF Regatta on Saturday will consist of a Pursuit Race with Designated Marks specified by BBYRA General Conditions and Sailing Instructions: Cruising, Sections CR4.1. All boats must monitor VHF Ch. 72.

The One-Design Regatta on Sunday will consist of three scheduled races, with Courses and Marks as specified by BBYRA General Conditions and Sailing Instructions, Sections 11 and 12.

One race each day will constitute a regatta. The Warning Signal for the first start of each day will be at 1130 hours.

- 7. Awards will be given each day following the racing at approximately 1700 Hours on Saturday and as soon as is practical after the last race on Sunday.
- 8. Any changes to the Sailing Instructions for the Races on either day will be posted on the Notice Board at the Coconut Grove Sailing Club by 1700 Hours on the previous day.
- 9. Parking inside the CGSC gates is for Members only. Parking is available at the Public Parking Lot next to the Sonesta Hotel special day rate of \$6 with stamped ticket @ CGSC Office.
