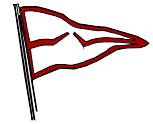

Rendezvous: In the vicinity of Triton Point on the USNA grounds.
There will be a mandatory check-in procedure for competitors prior to their start.

Start: The warning signal for the first class to start will be given at 1845.
The starting area will be off of Triton Point near the Navy YPs.

Signals: The warning signal for the first class to start will be given at 1845.
Classes will start at 5 minute intervals. See EYC Event Sailing Instructions.

Course: Point-to-point race from Annapolis to Solomons Island.

Time limit: See Event Sailing Instructions for specifics.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 (RRS). RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "*If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice Of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply.*"
The Event Sailing Instructions will be available on or before Thursday 03 July 2014 at the EYC clubhouse and on the EYC website (<http://race.eastportyc.org>).
All boats will use its PHRF rating.

Awards: Awards will be presented at the post-race party after racing.
Additionally, Beneteau America will award prizes to the top 3 Beneteaus in the Cruising or Corinthian Class, and the top three Beneteaus in the Handicap Classes. At the end of the year Beneteau America will award prizes to the overall winners of the Cruising/Corinthian Class and Handicap Classes.
