## Notice of Amendment #2 to the Sailing Instructions

The following items have been corrected to the Notice of Race.  
Changes are displayed in red. Please take note:

### **5.1 of the Stein Sailing Instructions are amended to read:**

#### 5.1 SATURDAY COURSE TO CATALINA ISLAND

- The starting line will be between a tetrahedron and an orange flag on the RC boat at the right-hand end in the vicinity of the MDR "H" "J" Mark. This mark is located approximately 0.6 ~~0.9~~ NM at a heading of ~~235~~ **230**° magnetic from the middle of the MDR detached breakwater
- The Course will be from the Starting leaving the El Segundo "2ES" buoy to port then leave the "West End" to port and then proceed to the finishing line near the Coast Guard buoy in Catalina Harbor. The finishing line will be an orange flag on or near the RC boat and an orange mark in the water. In the absence of the RC boat, record your time when your bow passes an imaginary line between the Coast Guard buoy and Pin Rock.

### **5 of the Berger Sailing Instructions are amended to read:**

#### 5. COURSES

#### 5.1 SATURDAY COURSE TO CATALINA ISLAND

- The starting line will be between a tetrahedron and an orange flag on the RC boat at the right-hand end in the vicinity of the MDR "H" "J" Mark. This mark is located approximately 0.6 ~~0.9~~ NM at a heading of ~~235~~ **230**° magnetic from the middle of the MDR detached breakwater.
