1. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *the Racing Rules of Sailing*, including appendix D. The regatta is classified as a Category A event.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Competing teams must represent an organization that is a member in good standing of SMSA. Only one team per organization.
- 2.3 Sailors must be members of the club they represent or full time participants in the club's junior sailing program.
- 2.4 Sailors shall be 18 or younger as of December 31st of this year.
- 2.5 Teams are limited to 8 sailors. Skippers and crew combinations may be changed between each race as long as they are done before the preparatory signal.

- 3.2 The Entry fee is \$200/team.
