NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2 ADVERTISING

Boats will not be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY

3.1 The regatta is open to competitors who have not and will not reach their 19th birthday in the year 2014.

3.2 The regatta is open to boats of the Optimist, C420, Laser, and Laser Radial classes.

3.3 Each skipper and a parent or guardian will be required to sign a waiver of liability before competing in this regatta.

4 CLASSIFICATION

5 FEES AND ENTRY

5.1 The entry fees are \$25.00 for the Optimist, Laser, and Laser Radial classes, and \$50.00 for the Club 420 class.

5.2 An additional entry fee of \$5.00 will be charged to any competitor who is not a member of CBYRA.

5.2 Boats wishing to enter shall register on line at www.annapolisyc.com/racing.

5.3 Registrations made after 27 June, 2014 will be subject to a \$5.00 late fee.

5.4 To be considered an entry, a boat must complete all requirements of registration and pay all fees.

5.5 The entry fee includes dinner at AYC on Tuesday, July 1, 2014. Additional dinner tickets may be purchased with the regatta entry for \$15.00 each.

6 SCHEDULE

6.2 Five races are scheduled for each class.

7 MEASUREMENT AND INSPECTION

No pre-regatta measurements or inspections will be required.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at on-site registration.

9 VENUE

- 9.1 Attachment 1 shows the layout of the regatta venue.
- 9.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing areas. When possible, the C420, Laser, and Laser Radial classes will race in Area A, the Optimist Red, White, and Blue fleets will race in Area B, and the Optimist Green fleet will race in Area C.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward, trapezoid, or triangular drop mark courses.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

Penalties while racing: RRS 44.1, One-Turn and Two-Turns Penalties will apply.

12 SCORING

- 12.1 RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.
- 12.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.3 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

13 TRAILER & SUPPORT BOAT LOGISTICS

- 13.1 Support and coach boats shall register with the Organizing Authority during on-site registration. No power boats may be launched at the AYC Sailing Center. Powerboats may launch on the ramp at Truxton Park.
- 13.2 Trailer loading and unloading may be done at the AYC Sailing Center (see Attachment 1) starting no sooner than 1730 June 30th. Trailers must be removed by 2000 on July 2nd.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors and coaches on VHF radio. The specific channel will be stated in the sailing instructions.

15 PRIZES

- 15.1 Prizes will be given to first, second and third places in the C420, Laser, Laser Radial, Optimist Red, Optimist White, and Optimist Blue classes.
- 15.2 Prizes will be given to first through fifth places for overall standing in the Optimist fleet.
- 15.3 A prize will be given to the top girl competitor in the Laser Radial, and Optimist fleets and to the top all girl boat in the C420 class.
- 15.4 All Optimist Green fleet competitors will receive participation awards.
- 15.5 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$US 300,000 per event or the equivalent.

18 SAFETY

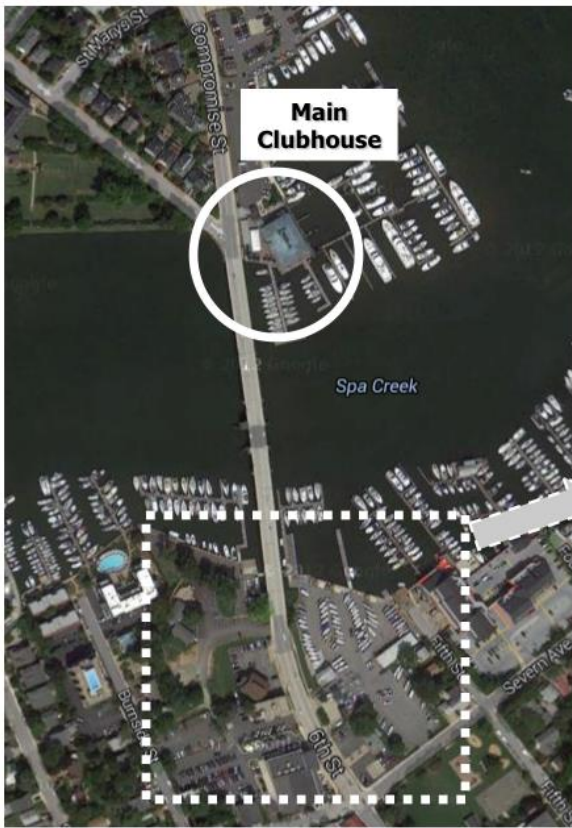
All competitors and coaches will be required to wear USCG approved Type III Personal Floatation Devices (PFDs) at all times while afloat, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.

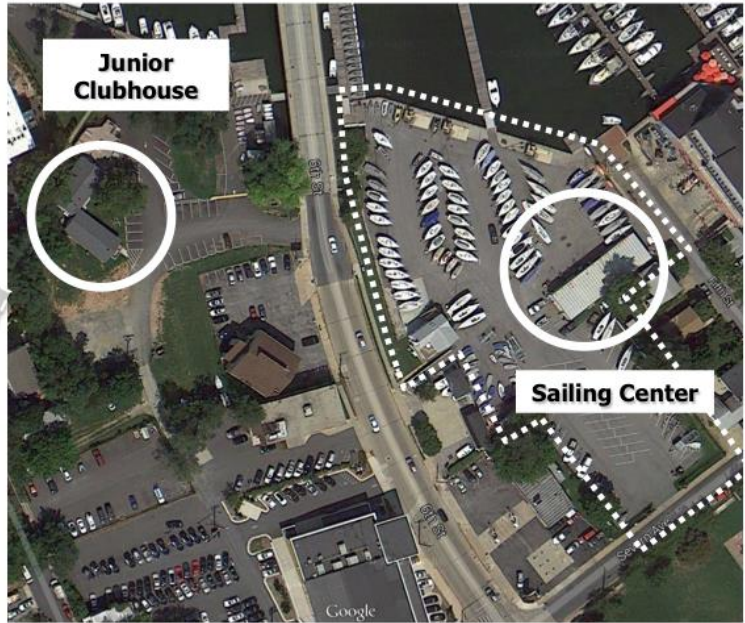
