

Notice of Race Monterey & Back Regatta

Saturday July 19-20, 2014

Santa Cruz Yacht Club, 244 Fourth Avenue, Santa Cruz, CA 95062

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Racing rule 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats holding a valid 2014 Monterey Bay PHRF rating.
- 2.2 One-Design boats are invited to participate as a class. If five boats of a single type register, they will form a class.
- 2.3 Based upon their PHRF rating, sails used while racing and number of crew, boats may enter one of the following Divisions:

A Fleet (PHRF <88)

B Fleet (PHRF >89)

Jib and Main (PHRF <181)

Jib and Main (PHRF >182)

The Organizing Authority reserves the right to modify the Divisions based upon entries received.

- 2.4 Eligible boats may only enter on-line at SCYC.org before 1000 hours, July 19, 2014.
- 2.5 A completed Float Plan of the attached form must be submitted as a part of registration. The float plan must be submitted prior to the competitor's meeting on Saturday July 19th.
- 2.6 The organizing authority reserves the right to reject an entry based on its sole opinion of the seaworthiness of the boat.

3.0 Fees

- 3.1 The regular entry fee is \$50. For all entries received after 1200 hours on **July 18** a late entry fee of \$95 will apply.
- 3.2 Entry does NOT include berthing in Monterey Harbor. Berthing may be arranged directly with MPYC (mpyc.org) or the Monterey Harbormaster at: <http://monterey.org/en-us/departments/harbormarina.aspx>
- 3.3 Entry does NOT include dinner at MPYC.

4.0 Schedule

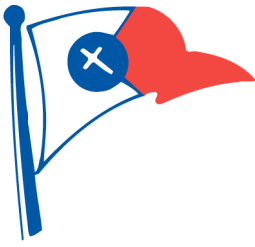
- 4.1 A competitor's meeting is scheduled for 1030 hours Saturday, July 19, 2014 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal for Saturday, July 19, 2014 is 1225 hours.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the first warning signal for Sunday, July 20, 2014 is 1225 hours.

5.0 Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available by **1100 on July 19, 2014** on-line and at the competitor's briefing.

6.0 Venue & Course

- 6.1 Racing will be in open waters of Monterey Bay between Santa Cruz and Monterey.
- 6.2 On Saturday July 19th the race will start in Santa Cruz and finish in Monterey.
- 6.3 On Sunday July 20th the race will start in Monterey and finish in Santa Cruz.
- 6.4 The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.



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7.0 Scoring

7.1 One race is required to complete the regatta.

7.2 There will be no throw-outs.

7.3 Scoring will be based on 2014 Monterey Bay PHRF ratings and will be scored time on distance.

8.0 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

8.1 The Race Committee may broadcast information about the day's racing on VHF 68. All boats will be required to check in before the start and before finishing. Please note that at check-in we will be asking for the total number of people on board, and if there has been any change from the online registration you will be asked to switch to VHF 72 to provide the new information. Check-in is not complete until confirmation is received from the Race Committee. Boats failing to check in with the Race Committee, including providing number of people on board, on VHF 68 will be scored DNC. This changes RRS

9.0 Prizes

9.1 Prizes will be awarded to each Division for first place and additional places based upon the number of entries at the discretion of the organizing authority. Awards will be at the SCYC clubhouse after racing on Sunday.

9.2 Boats entered in divisions with three (3) or more entries in the regatta are eligible for the Champion of Champions Regatta.

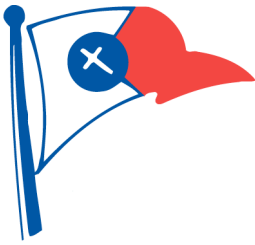
10.0 Disclaimer of Liability

By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

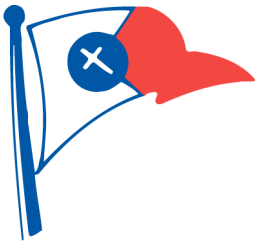

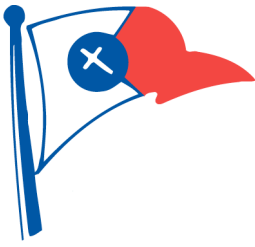
