# SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

## KITTY MUHL LADIES DAY RACE

JULY 26, 2014

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016 including the prescriptions of US Sailing: US Coast Guard "Navigational Rules, International Inland" 050-012-001922-8 (Inland Rules); the rules of Performance Handicap Racing Fleet San Diego (PHRF-SD) and by these sailing instructions (SI's). Racing boats encountering other racing boats are governed by RRS. Racing boats encountering non-racing boats shall conform to the Inland Rules. Interference with deep draft vessels will be grounds for disqualification by the Race Committee (RC).
- 1.2 This is a one race regatta in six classes with pursuit starts. The course is Random Leg Course (RLC) as defined by PHRF-SD. The organizing authority is the Coronado Yacht Club (CYC).

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to members of all yacht clubs and sailing associations recognized by the US Sailing.
- 2.2 The skippers of eligible boats may enter ONLY online at <http://coronadoyc.org>. Entries must be made no later than 0930 on race day. Changes to racing class or handicap after original sign up must be made with the Principal Race Officer (PRO), Glenn Welch. **Boats racing in class 1 and 2 will add the spinnaker offset in their total handicap when registering if racing non spinnaker. In addition, all female crews will add +17 to their rating.**
- 2.3 Class 1..... PHRF-SD RLC Rating of 113 or less, female skipper mixed crew
- 2.4 Class 2..... PHRF-SD RLC Rating of 114 or more, female skipper mixed crew
- 2.5 Class 3.....CYC Handicap Rating, female skipper mixed crew.

- 3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS:** Notices to competitors, including changes to SI's will be posted on the regatta page at <http://coronadoyc.org> and at the RC Notice Board located on the CYC clubhouse porch.

**4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE**

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the CYC clubhouse race committee flag hoist.

**5 SCHEDULE July 27, 2013**

- 5.1 0930, 27 July 2013 – deadline for registration.  
1045 - pursuit start times will be available at the CYC front desk.  
1200 - start time for the first starter.  
1630 - deadline to complete course.

**6 CLASS FLAGS**

- 6.1 A single red flag will serve as the class flag for the inverted start sequence.  
6.2 Competitors are encouraged to fly their class pennants while racing.

**7 TIME LIMITS**

- 7.1 Boats finishing after 1630 will be scored DNF (did not finish).  
7.2 Boats not finishing within one hour of the first finisher in their class will be scored DNF.  
7.3 Failure to meet these time limits will not be grounds for redress. This limit changes rule 35.

**8 THE COURSE & MARKS**

- 8.1 The course is random leg made up of both inflatable buoys and Glorietta Bay (GB) and San Diego Bay (SD) navigational buoys. "Diver" is an orange tetrahedron located approximately 60 meters south of the Starting Line. "A" is an orange tetrahedron located approximately 1.03 nm from SD 28 on a bearing of 240 magnetic (LAT/LONG: N32'40" W117'09").  
The starboard end of the Starting Line is a piling with a barber pole design located at the mouth of the CYC guest docks. The port end of the starting line is an orange flag.

- 8.2 Course length = 7.88 Nautical Miles

## **9. THE START**

- 9.1 This is an inverted start race. Start times, to the second, will be assigned to each racer with the high handicap racer starting at 12:00:00.
- 9.2 The start times will be available at the CYC front desk by 1045 on race day.
- 9.3 The Start will be started in accordance with RRS26 with Warning signal made at 1155 for the boat with the highest rating. This start time will start the clock for subsequent starters. As a courtesy, multiple horns will be sounded one minute prior to the Warning signal.

- 9.4 Recalls: Individual recalls will be signaled in accordance with racing rule 29.1. The sound signal will be the horn. The Race Committee will attempt to hail premature starters with a loud hailer. Failure of equipment, failure to hear a hail, delay in hailing or the order in which hails are given will not be grounds for redress.

## **10 PENALTIES**

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## **11 SCORING**

- 11.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A of RRS will apply.
- 11.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.3 There will be no throw outs.

## **12 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

The Race Committee will be monitoring channel 71.

13. **AWARDS** and prizes will be presented after the race at the covered patio area near the outdoor barbeque .
