

SYC Knarr Qualifier August 23rd 2014 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

This regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. Appendix T, Section A, T1 shall apply as follows: the first two sentences of RRS 44.1 are changed to: A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 while *racing*. However, when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 while in the *zone* around a *mark* other than the starting *mark*, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the <u>Sausalito YC website</u> and emailed to the Knarr Admiralty. Notices shall be posted no later than 1800 on the Friday the night before racing. If notices have been posted, the committee boat shall fly flag "L" in the racing area.

3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

No signals shall be made ashore.

4 SCHEDULE and CLASS FLAG

First Warning 1130 hrs.

Class Flag shall be a 2'x2' red flag with white Knarr logo "0".

Three races are scheduled. The Warning Signal for subsequent races shall be made as soon as practicable.

5 COURSES and MARKS

Courses and mark descriptions will be defined on Attachment A. Courses shall be designated by numerical pennant.

8 STARTING and FINISHING LINES

The intended starting area will be in the vicinity of Pt Knox, west of Angel Island. If conditions dictate, the committee boat may move to another area. If so, the race committee shall hail the fleet on VHF channel 71 and display the "L" flag. The starting and finishing line will be between an inflatable mark and a staff displaying an orange flag on the committee boat

9 TIME LIMIT

For all races the time limit shall be 15 minutes after the first boat in the class finishes that race. Boats finishing after the time limit shall be scored DNF. This changes RRS 35.

10 PROTESTS

Protests shall be in writing; forms will be available at the bar at Sausalito YC and delivered to the protest table within 60 minutes after the race committee signal boat docks.

The Protest time limit and a list of protests will be posted on the official notice board within 15 minutes of the end of protest time. This posting constitutes the notification required in RRS 61.1(b) and 63.2

11 SCORING

A minimum of one race shall be completed to constitute a series. All races count. No race shall be discarded. This changes RRS Appendix A2.

12 COMMUNICATIONS

RRS 25 is amended to allow for on-the-water radio communications between the R/C and racing boats on VHF channel 71. The R/C will communicate OCS and the signaled course for the race. The inability of a competitor to hear a hail for over early or any other information shall not relieve her of her responsibility, nor shall it be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 41 and 62.1.

COURSES WILL BE DISPLAYED BY NUMERICAL PENNANTS

Course 1 S - 1 - F Course 2 S - 1 - 2 - 1 - F

ALL MARKS SHALL BE TAKEN TO PORT, EXCEPT 2 (GATE). FOR THE GATE, BOATS SHALL PASS BETWEEN THE GATE MARKS FROM THE DIRECTION OF THE LAST MARK, THEN MAY ROUND IN EITHER DIRECTION.


IN THE EVENT A GATE MARK IS MISSING, THE REMAINING GATE MARK SHALL BE TAKEN TO PORT.


DESCRIPTION OF MARKS:

S/F Yellow Conical Mark

- 1 Orange Conical Mark
- 2 Orange Conical Mark(s)

Change marks shall be of a different color and/or shape than the original mark.
