

Authority: The Plymouth Yacht Club Junior Regatta is organized under the authority of the

Plymouth Yacht Club Regatta Committee and will be governed by the *Rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of U.S Sailing, U.S.O.D.A. Class Rules, Club 420 Class Rules, Optimist Class Rules, the Laser Class Rules, the Sailing Instructions,

and any other applicable rules.

Entries: International Optimist Dinghy Championship Line (White, Blue, and Red Fleets)

Green Line (Novice Optimist Sailors Only)

Limitations: All competitors (skippers and crew) shall not have reached their 19th birthday during

the 2014 calendar year.

All competitors (skippers and crew) shall provide a release form for medical care.

which must be signed by a parent or quardian if under 18 years of age.

Registration: Registration for this regatta may only be completed online at Regatta Network.

(www.regattanetwork.com). The entry fee is \$55.00 per person. A discount of \$15.00 will apply to those boats who register before 2400 hours on Friday, July 25, 2014.

Online registration closes Sunday, July 27, 2014 at 1700 hours.

Entry into the Regatta will be accepted the day of the event in person only.

Payment of the entry fee is required at the time of entry. Missing items will render the registration incomplete.

The registration package includes the following:

1. Online Registration / SMSA Medical Form both through Regatta Networks

2. Payment of entry fee - (includes breakfast buffet, on-the-water snack/drinks, BBQ, and T-Shirt)

3. Sailing instructions will be distributed the day of the race.

Scoring: The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A2 will apply.

One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

There will be no maximum number of races.

One throw out will be allowed after five races are completed.

Prizes: Awards for the first three places in each fleet as well as an overall award for Opti

Championship Fleet.

Coach boats: All visiting coach and support boats are required to check in before heading out onto

the water. Boats can be launched at the club or the town dock at the head of the harbor. Each coach boat shall have a working VHF radio, an anchor, and a basic first aid kit. No coaching is allowed after the first gun for each race (except for Green Fleet skippers

in the bottom half of any given race).

VHF: The Race Committee boats will be monitoring channel 72

Other: Snacks/Drinks will be provided to competitors on the water.

A BBQ will be provided to all participating sailors, coaches and parents after the race.

Parking for vehicles and trailers is available onsite.

For your convenience, boats may be dropped off the evening before the regatta from

5pm-7pm.
