- 1. Rules: This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing
- 2. Classes: This is a one-design regatta for mono-hull sailboats. Four boats registered by August 16, 2014, shall constitute a class. Classes established after this date will get trophies scrounged from my garage and include such items as old worn out sails, expired epoxy cans and short pieces of useless rope with a broken block.
- 3. Berthing: If you wish to tow your one-design boat behind your big boat to Blackbeard and sleep on your big boat, a limited amount of free slips are available at Blackbeard Sailing Club on a first-come, first-served basis. For details contact Blackbeard Sailing Club Dockmaster Bill Drechsler at <u>billhotchoc@hotmail.com</u>. Please include your Length, Beam and Draft in the first email. A shuttle service for boats anchored in Upper Broad Creek also may be available.
- 4. Lodging:
 - a. Free camping is available on site at Blackbeard. The club's bathhouse is nearby.
 - b. Resort Management Group at Fairfield Harbour. These weekend rental units are less than a mile from the club. Contact Gwen Hyman at 252-638-8011 or <u>guestservices@resortmgmtgroup.com</u>. Gwen has units that sleep eight and rent for around \$115/night.
 - c. Vacations Resorts International. These weekend rental units are less than a mile from the club. Contact Diana Morris 252-633-1151 or <u>theharbour@suddenlinkmail.com</u>. Diana has units that sleep eight and rent for around \$135/night, and she offers discounts to sailors.
- 5. Registration: The registration fee is \$25.00. Pre-registration will be online. See the link below.

 - b. Late Registration is after 8:00 PM Sunday August 17th and will be accepted for an additional \$10 charge. Please register early.
