NOTICE OF RACE

About the Century Turn Race

The Century Turn Trophy is an inaugural Race in Celebration of the 100th anniversary of the Charter of Edgewater Yacht Club. The course of the race will be the perimeter of the compass rose, finishing at the Pavilion. Party to follow. Each crew is encouraged to bring food to share. A keg of beer will be provided.

RULES

All races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

JAM sail limitations and equipment restrictions for JAM participants are governed by PHRF-LE rules for non-spinnaker fleets.

Rules restricting the user of VHF radio, Loran and/or GPOS for all classes are waived.

JAM, T-10 and PHRF Class Rules are changed to require that each boat carry no less than three, including the skipper and crew members.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

This event is open to PHRF, JAM and One-Design monohull boats whose owners are members of Edgewater Yacht Club (EWYC) or other Inter-Lake Yachting Association (I-LYA) Clubs. Eligible boats shall register using online registration at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/8938>

MEASUREMENT

A boat and/or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the Class Rules, the Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race. Except for on-line, entrants shall submit copy of their valid PHRF-LE Rating Certificate by the registration deadline. Boats without a current PHRF-LE Measurement Certificate may be assigned a temporary rating at the discretion of the Race Committee which shall be valid for this race only and cannot be appealed.

FEES

Required fees for the Century Turns Trophy Race are listed on the registration form and must be paid in-full prior to the close of registration.

SKIPPER'S MEETING

All skippers, or their designated representative, are required to attend the Skipper's Meeting at 9:30am the morning of the race.

RACING AREA AND COURSE

All racing shall take place on Lake Erie north of Edgewater Yacht Club on the Edgewater Fixed Mark Compass Rose.

Starts will be at "S-Mark" to a windward mark designated and displayed on the Committee Boat. Leaving the weather mark to port, all classes are to sail around the Compass rose leaving the original weather mark to port and finishing between the RC Boat and the "S-Mark."

1st warning is at 10:25am. PHRF will start at 10:30am followed by JAM at 10:35am. T-10s will not have a separate start and will start with the PHRF Fleet.

SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A2, will apply.
