**INVITATION:** You are cordially invited to participate in the 2014 Colorado Governor's Cup, hosted by the Dillon Yacht Club (DYC), the Nation's highest yacht club.

## **ELIGIBILITY/FLEETS/CLASSES**

Open to all Keelboats, dinghy, one-design, PHRF and Portsmouth racing. Fleet/Class racing will be available to those Classes registering 5 or more boats. Classes not able to form a fleet will race in their appropriate PHRF or Portsmouth division. Boats racing in the PHRF Fleet must have a current Sailing Association of Intermountain Lakes (SAIL) PHRF certificate. Annual Certificates, which include membership to S.A.I.L. are \$15, or temporary one-regatta certificate is \$5, can be purchased during check-in. For non S.A.I.L. PHRF members, ratings will be determined by the OA/PRO. PHRF ratings are available on the SAIL website. Classes may be started together but will be scored separately.

**REGISTRATION FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED WITH ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION INCLUDED PRIOR TO REGISTRATION DEADLINES OR ENTRY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.**

## **RULES**

This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the US Sailing current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Sailing Instructions will be available during registration check in. The Dillon Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority.

Regatta packages and sailing instructions will be available at registration starting at 1700, August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

**COURSES:** Keel Boat courses will be sailed in the main portion of Lake Dillon. Dinghy racing will take place in Dillon Bay.

**NUMBER OF RACES PLANNED:** Up to 8 races are planned for the keel boats; more may be sailed for the Dinghies. Races will be run back to back. One race shall constitute a regatta.

**SCORING:** The Low Point Scoring System described in Appendix A of the US Sailing current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) will be used.

**TROPHIES:** First, second and third places trophies will be awarded to the winning boat in each class with 5 or more boats.

**FACILITIES:** Dillon Marina has overnight slips, showers and restrooms that are available to all regatta participants and guests. **Small boats may launch and utilize the Dillon Beach adjacent to the launch ramp.** Please contact the Dillon Marina office at (970) 468-5100 for slip availability. Trailer storage will be provided by the Town of Dillon and designated at the time of check in by obtaining a trailer permit at no charge from the Dillon Marina office. **ALL BOATS MUST COMPLY WITH STATE MANDATED AQUATIC NUISANCE INSPECTION GOING INTO AND COMING OUT OF THE WATER.**
