RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. USCG approved life jackets are required for each sailor. The provisions of Appendix T, rule T1 and T2, are in effect for this regatta.

ELIGIBILITY

The regatta is open to sailboats with removable centerboards, including Optimists, Sunfish and Lasers.

Junior age eligibility during all of 2014:

Laser:

- Laser full-rig-under 21
- Laser radial-under 19
- Laser 4.7-under 18

Junior age eligibility at the regatta:

Sunfish:

- Midget-under 15
- Junior-under 19

Optimist ages at the regatta:

- Green- novice, under 15
- White-10 or under
- Blue-11 or 12
- Red-13, 14 or 15

FEES

Registration: Adult - \$45

Junior - \$35

Late Penalty (after 9/17) \$10 US SAILING member: Subtract \$5

SCORING

Appendix A, Low Point Scoring System will be used. One race will constitute a Regatta for all divisions. If less than six races are sailed, each boat's score will be the sum of her scores for all races.

PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded based on number of boats registered by September 17th as follows:

2: 1 award

3 - 5: 2 awards

6-8: 3 awards

9+: 4 awards

LAUNCHING & FACILITIES

Boats may launch from the beach by the pavilion, the point or any ramp area. Camping is welcome with plenty of lakefront site available. Shower and restroom facilities are available at the Clubhouse. Open fires and pets are not permitted at LNYC.
