# **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing* and the ASMBYC Championship Regatta Rules (available at www.asmbyc.org/race/).
- 1.2 The prescriptions of USSA and the event sailing instructions shall apply.
- 1.3 Rules 63.1, A4.1 and A5 will be changed so that a boat starting more than five (5) minutes after her Starting Signal will be scored DNS without a hearing.
- 1.4 Rule 63.7 will be replaced with: "If there is any conflict between a rule in the Notice of Race and one in the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall apply."
- 1.5 Rule 82 will not apply to this event.
- 1.6 Appendix A2 will be changed so that each boat's series score shall be the total of all her race scores.
- 1.7 Appendix T, Section A, Penalties While Racing, and Section C, Expedited Hearings, will apply.
- 1.8 Appendix T, Section B, Post-Race Penalties will apply with the following modification: the minimum 20% penalty is 2 places, and the minimum 30% penalty is 3 places.
- 1.9 The PHRF of Southern California (SoCal PHRF) "Marine Industry Racer Rule" will not apply.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This is an **invitational** regatta. Entrants must qualify per the ASMBYC Championship Regatta Rules (available at <a href="www.asmbyc.org/race/">www.asmbyc.org/race/</a>). For the purpose of qualification, a skipper and boat shall be considered a single entity.
- 2.2 To be eligible for entry:
  - (a) Each boat must be entered by an individual who is a member of an ASMBYC member yacht club or sailing association
  - (b) A boat racing in a PHRF class must have a valid SoCal PHRF Rating Certificate (Information about joining SoCal PHRF is available at <a href="https://www.phrfsocal.org">www.phrfsocal.org</a> or at 562.438.6712).
  - (c) A boat racing in a one-design class must fulfill the eligibility requirements of her class.
  - (d) A boat racing in a Cruising class shall submit a completed <u>ASMBYC Cruiser Class Adjustment</u> Form to the KHYC front desk (or by fax: 310.374.5848) by 1900 hours on Thursday, September 20, 2014.
- 2.3 Each entrant shall complete the online entry process at <a href="http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/9048">http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/9048</a> or submit a Paper Entry at the KHYC front desk and pay all fees prior to 1900 hours on Thursday, September 18, 2014. Paper entries should be accompanied by a check payable to "ASMBYC".
- 2.4 Entries submitted after the times listed in **NOR2.3** will be accepted only with the prior approval of the Regatta Chair.

#### 3. CLASSES

- 3.1 Classes will be established for PHRF, One-Design and Cruising fleets with a minimum of four (4) entries from qualifying skippers, based on entries received by 1900 hours on Thursday, September 18, 2014. Boats entered as one-design, for which a class was not established, may race PHRF, in their one-design configuration, with a current PHRF certificate
- 3.2 Displacement and performance factors will be considered when establishing PHRF classes in an effort to provide like-racing for competitors.
- 3.3 Classes, class flags and order of starts will be posted on the Official Notice Board located on the first floor opposite the Race Committee Room by 2000 hours, Friday, September 19, 2014.

### 4. FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee for race boats 50 feet and above is \$100
- 4.2 The entry fee for all other race boats is \$50
- 4.3 The entry fee for cruisers is \$25
- 4.4 There will be a \$10 late fee for entries accepted after 1900 hours on Thursday, September 18.

- 5.1 PHRF and One-Design classes will have four (4) races: three (3) races on Saturday and one (1) on Sunday.
- 5.2 Cruising Class will have one (1) race on Sunday only
- 5.3 Without posting a change to the schedule of races, the Race Committee (RC) reserves the right to run one more race on Sunday if fewer than the scheduled number of races are completed on Saturday. The RC, at its discretion, may run fewer total races.

### 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at the KHYC front desk by 1200 hours on Wednesday, September 17, 2014 and will be posted at <a href="http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/9048">http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/9048</a> and <a href="http://www.asmbyc.org">www.asmbyc.org</a>.

## 7. VENUE

The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay between the Hermosa and Manhattan piers and will use inflatable marks that may be Orange or Yellow.

#### 8. THE COURSES

Saturday's courses will be primarily windward/leeward between Hermosa and Manhattan piers Sunday's race will be a random leg race. One design fleets may petition the regatta chair to have buoy races on both Saturday and Sunday.

### 9. SCORING

- 9.1 All race scores will count.
- 9.2 On Saturday, PHRF classes will be scored using Area B Buoy Ratings, and on Sunday PHRF classes will be scored using Area B Random Leg Ratings. Boats from outside of Area B will have Area B adjustments applied as available. Both the Buoy Rating and the Random Leg Rating must be specified on the entry form.
- 9.3 Cruising Class entrants will use PHRF Area B ratings as adjusted by the <u>ASMBYC Cruiser Class</u> Adjustment Form, submitted by each cruising class entrant per **NOR 2.2 (d).**
- 9.4 Scoring will be calculated using the Time on Distance method and ratings as described in **NOR9.2** and 9.3.
- 9.5 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a series.

## 10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

While on the water, the RC may communicate with competing boats via VHF radio channel 78, including starting penalties.

## 11. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded after racing on Sunday. Individual take home trophies will be awarded based on the number of entries received. Perpetual trophies will be awarded to the winners of each class as appropriate.

#### 12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

### 13. HOSPITALITY
