Notice of Race

Alum Creek Lake, Lewis Center, OH

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available, no later than October 10th, 2014 on the Alum Creek Sailing Association's web site, at <http://www.alumcreeksailing.com>

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. This regatta is open to all sailboats, both Keel boats and Multihull. (Fleets are typically keelboats from 17'-28', One Design Fleets and Multihull Sailboats if there are enough to make a fleet)
- 3.2. Eligible boats shall be entered by completing registration with the organizing authority, Alum Creek Sailing Association, including required fees and certificates, prior to the Competitor Meeting.
- 3.3. Any one-design class will be scored as a fleet and may be given its own start at the discretion of the Race Committee. A class will be made up of a minimum of 4 boats.
- 3.4. Those keelboats and large multi-hulls not racing one-design must have a valid ACSA PHRF certificate on file or must present an ACSA approved valid PHRF certificate at registration.
- 3.5. Multihull fleets will be scored based on the Portsmouth rating system
- 3.6. On-line entry forms are available on the ACSA website at alumcreeksailing.com or on the morning of the regatta prior to the Competitor Meeting.

4. FEES

Entry fee shall be \$35 per boat. For members of ACSA or another I-LYA affiliate club, entry fee shall be \$30 per boat. U.S. Sailing members receive an additional \$5 discount. Please have membership card(s) available.

5. SCHEDULE

Registration and Competitor meeting will be held at the Alum Creek Sailing Facility, located off Lewis Center road

- Saturday 09:00 Registration
- Saturday 10:00 Competitor Meeting
- Saturday 11:00 First Warning Signal
- Sunday 10:00 First Warning signal

Races will continue at the discretion of Race Committee with no race beginning after 4:00 pm Saturday or after 2:00 pm Sunday

6. COURSES

The courses will be windward leeward, with a possible offset mark.

The course for each race will be signaled from the committee boat at the beginning of each race, no later than the warning signal, as defined in rule 26.

7. VENUE

Racing will take place on Alum Creek Lake between the dam and the Cheshire Road bridge. The Alum Creek Sailing Facility is located at GPS Coordinates N 40 11.911, W 82 58.436.

8. SCORING

The Low-Point Scoring System (rule A4.1) will apply with the following modification:

8.1. If fewer than four races are completed, no scores will be excluded.

8.2. If 4-6 races are completed, each competitor's worst score will be excluded

8.3. If more than six races are completed, each competitor's two worst scores will be excluded

9. AWARDS

Prizes will be awarded to the first three places in each fleet.
