1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the current ISSA Procedural Rules (as modified by the PCISA).

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at www.stfyc.com. Entries must be received **by Friday, September 19th** to take advantage of the discounted entry fee.

3 FEES

Entry fee is \$35 **if received by Friday, September 19th**. A late fee of \$15 will be assessed to entries received on or after September 20th.

5 BOATS & FORMAT

5.1 The regatta will be sailed in Laser Full Rigs and Laser Radials. Each competitor must provide their own complete class legal boat.

5.2 This will be a non-rotational regatta. The boat brought will be the boat sailed in all races. This changes ISSA Rule 7.6(a).

6 RACING AREA

The intended race area will be set on the City Front utilizing inflatable marks.

7 COACHING

Coaching can be done from the beach east of StFYC or from a boat supplied by the host.
