Fleet 48 at Lake Norman Yacht Club, Mooresville, NC invites you to our annual Fall 48 Regatta located on North Carolina's largest lake. This year's theme is Fall 48 for \$48

The event was started 17 years ago as a season ending 5 race no frills, low cost event designed to draw many of the best sailors east of the Mississippi. Today you can expect expert race management, tough competition, great food, and an opportunity to strengthen your sailing friendships. In keeping with offering great value, Fleet 48 is offering a special "thank you" rate to say "thanks" for supporting past LNYC events. The Regatta kicks off on Friday with an on the water clinic with Ryan Malmgren of MAD Sails. We are also providing an opportunity for you to support Community Sailing (see #13 below).

- 1. Rules The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2. Eligibility and Crew The regatta is open to all Flying Scots, and all competitors must be current members of the FSSA. You can join FSSA by going to <u>www.fssa.com</u> or calling 800-445-8629.

- 5. **Sailing Instructions** Sailing instructions will be available at registration at the LNYC Clubhouse, and the NOR will be posted on the Official Notice Board on the lower level of the Race Management Center.
- 6. **Number of Races** A maximum of five races are scheduled, and one race must be completed to constitute the Fall 48 regatta.
- 7. Courses: Windward Leeward courses with variations
- 8. Scoring Will be according to the RRS Appendix A Low Point system.
- 9. **Hailing OCS:** VHF radios may be carried aboard. As a courtesy, after the starting signal, the Race Committee will attempt to hail boats (including by VHF radio) that are OCS and boats that have not complied with RRS 30.1. The delay of such hails, the order of hailing, the lack of a hail, or failure of a competitor to hear such a hail shall not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- 10. **Safety** A boat retiring from a race shall notify a Race Committee vessel before leaving the course, or when that is impossible, as soon as possible after arrival ashore.
- 11. **Club Info** Camping at the club is free to everyone; however pets and open fires are not allowed. Please visit <u>www.lnyc.org</u> for directions. Note that our new, replacement pavilion is under construction and the area of the old pavilion is off limits.
- 12. Prizes Trophies will be awarded as follows:
 - a. Fall 48, 1st 5th places
- 13. Registration The options are:
 - a. <u>Online</u> **This allows you to pay by credit card.** <u>Click here</u> to register and pay online. You will need to sign the Release and Waiver on-site at the Registration table.
 - b. <u>Standard Mail</u> Fill out the Entry Form on the next page, sign the Release and Waiver, and mail the form and your check to the name and address at the bottom of the form.
 - c. <u>On-site</u> See NOR 4. Event Schedule for the date, time and location.
- 14. **OPPORTUNITY TO HELP COMMUNITY SAILING:** Fleet 48 Supports NC Community Sailing located on Lake Norman. NCCSR owns 14 Flying Scots used in weekly learn-to-sail and racing programs. Your entry fee will be waived (or refunded) if you donate at the registration table any of the following items that you deem to be worth \$48 or more and of reasonable value to NCCSR. A letter acknowledging your donation will also be sent to you.
