**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).  
**1.2** Racing rule 40 will be changed as follows: Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except when below deck or briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

**2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1** The following classes are invited to participate: Mercury, Star, Moore 24.  
**2.2** Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at [www.stfyc.com](http://www.stfyc.com). Entries must be received by Wednesday, October 15<sup>th</sup> in order to take advantage of the discounted entry fee.  
**2.3** Classes must have a minimum of six boats registered by October 15<sup>th</sup> in order to qualify for a class start.

**3 FEES**

- 3.1** For the Mercury and Star classes, the entry fee is \$95 if received **by Wednesday, October 15<sup>th</sup>**. A late fee of \$50 will be assessed to entries received October 16<sup>th</sup> or later.  
**3.2** For the Moore 24 class, the entry fee is \$130 if received **by Wednesday, October 15<sup>th</sup>**. A late fee of \$50 will be assessed to entries received October 16<sup>th</sup> or later.
