### 1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing

### 2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1 All entrants shall be current & paid members of the International Laser Class Association.

2.2 Proof of ILCA membership will be required at Registration, and ILCA forms will be available.

2.4 Classes include Laser Standard, Laser Radial and Laser 4.7.

### 3. Fees

3.1 The early entry fee is \$75, & includes full use of the facilities of the SSS, water between races, continental breakfast each day, a t-shirt, Saturday dinner, Sunday Pizza, and limited keg beer.

3.2 A late fee of \$25.00 will be charged after November 28, 2014.

3.3 Extra dinners are available for \$15.

### 5. Inspection and Measurement

5.1 Boats, gear, and sails may be inspected at any time for conformance to Class Rules.

5.2 Sail numbers must be the full 5 or 6 digits, applied in accordance with Class Rules, and have the builder button.

### 7. Courses

Courses will be windward-leeward or triangle as shown in the sailing instructions.

### 8. Scoring

8.1 One race must be completed to constitute a regatta. Three races must be completed for ILCA-NA Grand Prix points.

8.2 When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

### **9. Prizes**

At least 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class. More trophies may be awarded based on entries received by November 24<sup>th</sup>.
