NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Racing rule 40 will be changed as follows: Competitors in all fleets except Kiteboard and Windsurf shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Competitors in the Kiteboard and Windsurf classes shall wear wetsuits with a minimum thickness of 3/2mm, which cover the knees and have short sleeves as minimum coverage. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 Kiteboarders shall wear numbered jerseys.
- 1.4 Formula Boards must have sail numbers visible on all sails.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The following classes are invited to participate: 29er, 49er/49erFX, 505, Club 420, F18, Finn, Formula Kite, Formula Windsurf, Hydrofoil Kite, Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, Laser Standard, Vanguard 15, and Weta.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at www.stfyc.com. Entries must be received by Wednesday, October 22nd in order to take advantage of the discounted entry fee.
- 2.3 Classes must have a minimum of six boats registered by October 22nd in order to qualify for a class start.

3 FEES

- 3.1 For singlehanded classes, the entry fee is \$65 **if received by October 22nd**.
- 3.2 For doublehanded classes, the entry fee is \$95 **if received by October 22nd**.
- 3.3 A late fee of \$25 will be assessed to entries received October 23rd or later.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6 RACING AREA

The intended racing area will be set on the San Francisco City Front.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 One race will constitute a series.
- 7.2 If fewer than five races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. If five or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.

8 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors shall participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see RRS 4, DECISION TO RACE). The Organizing Authority does not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

BOAT & TRAILER STORAGE

All yachts competing in the event may be stored free of charge at StFYC one night prior to the beginning of racing and one night after racing concludes. If you plan on leaving a trailer in the City parking lot, you need to obtain an overnight parking permit from the StFYC Race Office. All boats & trailers shall be stored at the direction of the StFYC Dockmaster.
