



SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2014 Leukemia Fantasy Sail

November 22nd

1. **ORGANIZING AUTHORITY**

This regatta is organized by the Savannah Yacht Club in conjunction with the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society.

2. **RULES:**

The regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2013 – 2016)

3. **NOTICES TO COMPETITORS:** Notices to competitors & results will be posted on the Event Website

The Race Committee will communicate to competitors course intentions via VHF Channel 72. This includes OCS notifications to competitors as well as course for the next class. Failure to hear this radio communication is not grounds for any redress. Official Notice Board will be located in/adjacent to the Main Clubhouse.

4. **CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Official Notice Board before 0900 hrs on Saturday for the morning flight and by 1300 hrs for the afternoon flight.

5. **SCHEDULE:**

SATURDAY – November 22nd

0800 hrs	Owner's Briefing
0900 hrs	1 st Flight Participants board boats at front dock
0930 hrs	First Warning Gun, 1 st Flight, Second race to follow if possible
1200 hrs	Back to SYC docks for Lunch on the Bluff
1200 – 1300 hrs	Lunch on SYC Bluff
1300 hrs	2 nd Flight participants board assigned boats
1330 hrs	First Warning Gun, 2 nd Flight, Second race to follow if possible
1600 hrs	2 nd Flight concludes racing and returns to hotel
1830 – 1930 hrs	Cocktail Reception SYC Main Clubhouse
1930 – 2115 hrs	Dinner and Awards SYC Main Clubhouse
2115 hrs	Participants and Guests board buses back to hotel

6. **CLASS FLAGS:**

PHRF A will use Solid Green Flag

PHRF B will use Solid Yellow Flag

7. **RACING AREA:** The racing area will be the Wilmington, Skidaway Rivers and Wassaw Sound. See Chart.

8. **COURSES:** Courses to be sailed as shown in Appendix A (One-Design) and Appendix B (PHRF). All courses to be sailed will be displayed from the Course Board on the R/C Signal Boat (or Tower) prior to that classes Start.

8.1 PHRF COURSES: The R/C will also attempt to hail the next class's course prior to their warning signal via VHF.

8.2 Failure to hear the course via VHF shall not constitute grounds for redress.

10. **MARKS:** see course diagrams in the back of the Sailing Instructions (Appendix A for One-Design, Appendix B for PHRF) for the approximate shape, color and location of the marks intended to be used for this event. R/C may substitute any color or shape mark to maintain same approximate course configuration.

10.1 All Government Marks must honored while *racing*.

- 11 **THE START:** Succeeding classes will be started at any time after the starting signal for the preceding class by displaying the warning signal for the succeeding class.
- 11.1 A boat shall start no later than 5 minutes after her starting signal.
- 11.2 The start for all classes will be in accordance with *RRS 26*.
- 11.3 **STARTING LINE:** The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Signal Boat (or SYC Tower) and an Orange Tetrahedron.
- 12 **THE FINISH:** The finish line will be between an Orange Flag on the Finish Boat (or SYC Tower) and an Orange Tetrahedron.
- 13 **TIMELIMITS:** 75 minute time limit per race.
- 14 **SAFETY:** The safety of a boat and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the skipper who must decide whether or not to start or continue to race.
- 14.1 All PHRF competitors are *encouraged* to wear life jackets. **All competitors below the age of 16 must wear a lifejacket.**
- 14.2 SYC designated safety boats and coach boats may display a bright yellow flag with a black number on it.
- 15 **NO DISCHARGING TRASH:** After a hearing, any competitor observed discharging trash into the waters of the racing area may be scored DSQ for the day's racing.

PHRF Courses Using Government Marks / SYC Marks

Notifications to competitors regarding courses shall be displayed on the course board on the R/C Boat prior to (and during) that classes preparatory signal. The R/C will also attempt to hail the course configuration, and next class to start via VHF channel 72 prior to the preparatory signal for that class. Failure to hear such notification shall not be grounds for redress.

All Government Marks shall be honored while racing.


In addition to the courses listed in Appendix B, Course Symbols that may be displayed on the course board are noted below. All Mark roundings are to Starboard

SYMBOL DISPLAYED	INDICATES
S	Start (between orange flag & SYC Orange Tetrahedron)
F	Finish (between orange flag and SYC Orange Tetrahedron)
W	Windward Mark (SYC Green Tetrahedron)
L	Leeward Mark (SYC Green Tetrahedron)
O	Mark in Skidaway (SYC Green Tetrahedron)
H	Start or Finish in front of SYC Dock (between orange flag and SYC Orange Tet)


2014 SYC COURSES

PHRF courses will substitute an orange Tet for the starting pin.






