NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Racing rule 40 will be changed as follows: Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- The following classes are invited to participate: J/70, J/105, J/111, J/120, Express 27, Folkboat, J/24, Knarr, Melges 24, Moore 24, Open 5.70, and J/22 type boats.
- Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at www.stfyc.com. Entries must be received by Wednesday, March 11th in order to take advantage of the discounted entry fee.
- 2.3 Classes must have a minimum of six boats registered by March 11th in order to qualify for a class start.
- 2.4 A limited number of J/22 type boats are available for charter to eligible StFYC members.

3 FEES

- 3.1 For the J/105, J/111, and J/120 classes, entry fee is \$180 if received by March 11th.
- 3.2 For all other classes, the entry fee is \$130 if received by March 11th.
- **3.3** A late fee of \$50 will be assessed to entries received March 12th or later.
