Aquavit's spin was the result of being hit by Northern Lights.						
Northern Lights broke RRS 12 and RRS 14. Aquavit broke RRS 11 but was compelled to do so and is exonerated under RRS 64.1(a).						
Aquavit and Heart of Gold could not have reasonably avoided the contact.						
Northern Lights has already taken a penalty for the incident.
