

DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT (use another sheet if necessary)  1) Heart of Gold (leeward), Aquavit (middle) and Northern Lights (windware) were close hauled and overlapped on Starboard tack approximately 30 seconds after the start.  2) Northern Lights changed course to sail below Aquavit and hit Aquavit's stern. 3) Immediately after the contact between Aquavit and Northern Light, Aquavit's bow hit HoG's stern 1.5 feet forward of her aft most point 4) HoG immediately hailed protest and	See attached sketch
unfurled a red flag.  5) HoG suffered a puncture on her starboard side, 1.5 feet forward of her aft most point.	
6) Northern Lights performed 720° turn subsequent to her contact with Aquavit	
7) HoG is protesting Aquavit on Rule 11, On the same tack, overlapped:	
"When boats are on the same <b>tack</b> and <b>overlapped</b> , a <b>windward</b> boat shall <b>keep clear</b> of a <b>leeward</b> boat."
